

The nature of my invention consists in providing on the face of said plane an attachment of boxwood the fore part of which, or that part thereof which is forward of the plane iron being movable by means of 15 a screw attachment, A and key B, thereby regulating with ease and certainty the size of the mouth and the working of the plane, and producing much smoother and nicer

work—and to regulate the size of the mouth it is only necessary to start said key and 20 screw. The durability of the plane is also

The application to the common plane of 25 the screw attachment and key, through the same, thereby regulating the mouth and

greatly increasing its value.
