IMPROVED LINIMENT.

Specification forming part of Letters Patent No. 43,847, dated August 16, 1864.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Julia E. Gould, of Jamestown, in the State of New York, have invented certain new and useful Improvements in the Manufacture of Liniment for the Cure of Rheumatism and other Similar Affections; and I hereby declare that the following is a true and exact description of said manufacture.

The nature of my invention consists in combining certain ingredients, in the proportions hereinafter specified, for making a new and improved liniment.

In the vials accompanying this specification I furnish the component parts of my liniment in diminished quantities, but in the exact proportions specified below. The following are the ingredients with their relative pro-

portion: oil cajeput, three ounces; oil origanum, three ounces; oil sassafras, three ounces; oil olive, four ounces; oil cedar, three ounces; spearmint, one-half ounce; aqua ammonia, four ounces; tincture camphor, two ounces; red sanders, one-quarter ounce; alcohol, one gallon—these ingredients to be put in glass bottles and tightly stopped until used.

Having thus described my invention, what I claim, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

A liniment composed of the ingredients and in the proportions herein set forth.
