JOHN THURMON, OF PIKE COUNTY, MISSOURI.

IMPROVED MEDICAL COMPOUND.

Specification forming part of Letters Patent No. 47,140, dated April 4, 1865.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Dr. JOHN THURMON, of the county of Pike and State of Missouri, have invented or produced a new Medical Compound, known and designated as "Thurmon's Compound Blood-Purifier;" and I do further declare that the following is a full and exact description of the same.

Said medical compound is of a purely vegetable character, and is produced by distilling together in pure water, of sarsaparilla, one part; of running-brier root, one part; of poke-root, one part; cherry-tree bark, one-half part;

burr-vine, one-half part; blood-root, one-half part; mullen-root, one-half part. All of said ingredients must be distilled together for the space of twelve hours.

I claim as my invention and desire to secure by Letters Patent—

The medical compound prepared as described.
