


IMPROVED HINGE.

Specification forming part of Letters Patent No. 54,171, dated April 24, 1866.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, DAVID C. JORDON, Sr., of Brooklyn, county of Kings, State of New York, have invented a new and Improved Butt-Hinge; and I do hereby declare that the following is a full and exact description thereof, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, and to the letters of reference marked thereon.

The nature of my invention is an extra flange or leaves cast with the butt-hinge. The old butt-hinge generally screwed on the edge of the door and edge of the jamb; but the improved screws on the face and edge of the door and face and edge of jamb, which makes it firm and durable.

No. 1 in the cut represents the old butt with two leaves, and partly the new flange a; but the perspective cut represents the application of the improvement as screwed upon the door and jambs, as seen in the cut. No. 1 is the old flange or leaves. a a are the new flange or leaves.

I claim—

The butt-hinge with flange or leaves to screw upon the face and edge of the door and upon edge and face of the jamb, constructed as described.
