IMPROVED COMPOSITION FOR ROOFING.

Specification forming part of Letters Patent No. 57.874, dated September 11, 1866.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, CARY K. DANIEL and STEVEN F. DANIEL, both of Covington, Kenton county, Kentucky, have invented a new and useful Composition for Paving, Roofing, and other Purposes; and we do hereby declare the following to be a full, clear, and exact description thereof.

For paving and building purposes we take hydraulic cement, one and one-half barrel; bitter water or drainings from salt-works, three gallons; coal-pitch or asphalt, or residuum of petroleum, one-half barrel. Put all together into a kettle and bring to the boiling-point. Boil and stir for about fifteen minutes until thoroughly blended. Just before using stir in coarse sharp sand, five bushels; coarse gravel, five bushels.

For paving, spread the cement to the desired depth over the ground and roll with a hot roller. For building-blocks, run into suitable molds. For roofing, add twenty pounds Spanish whiting to the above ingredients and spread and roll.

We claim-

The composition herein described, composed and compounded as described, for the purposes stated.
