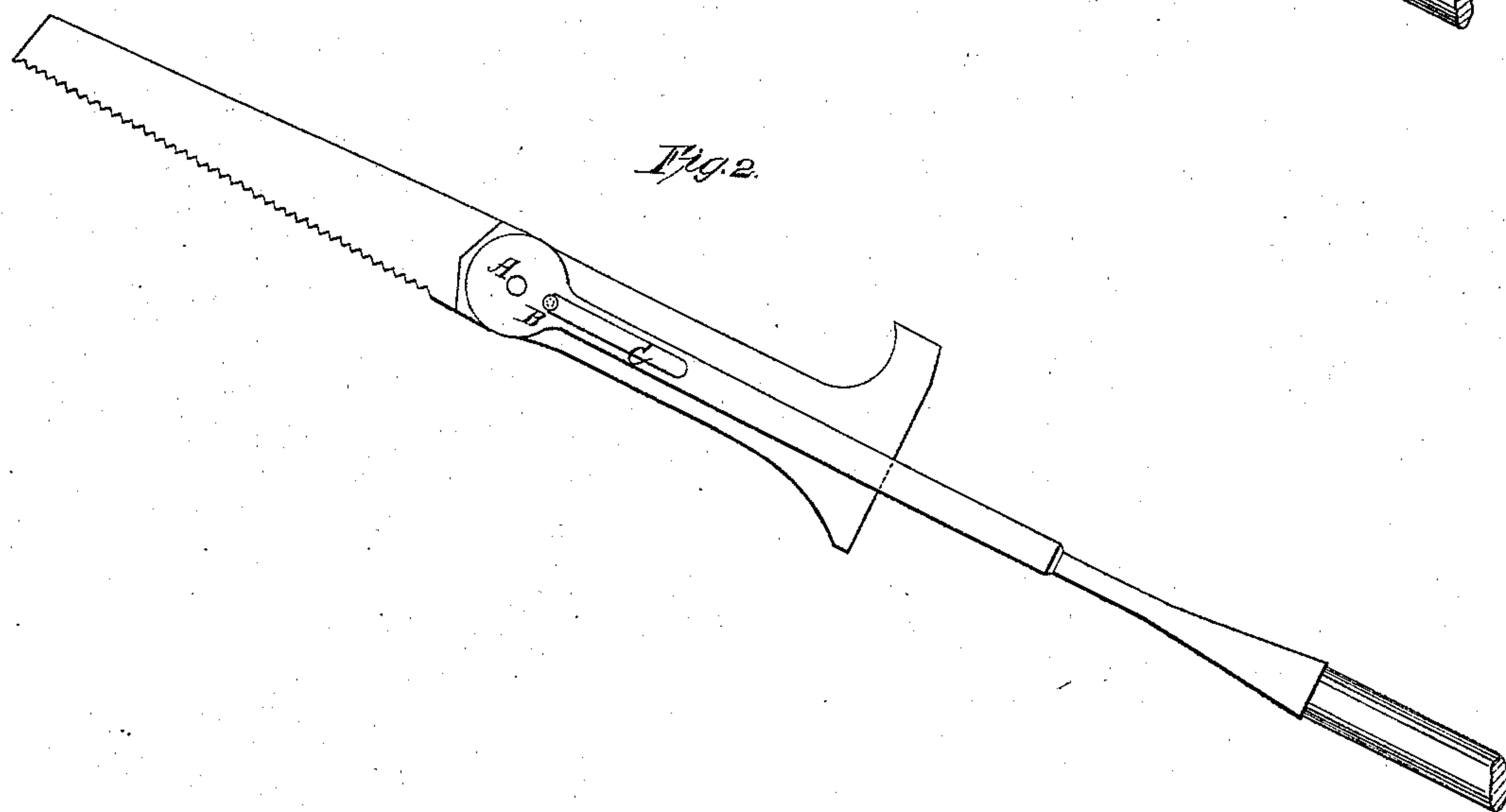
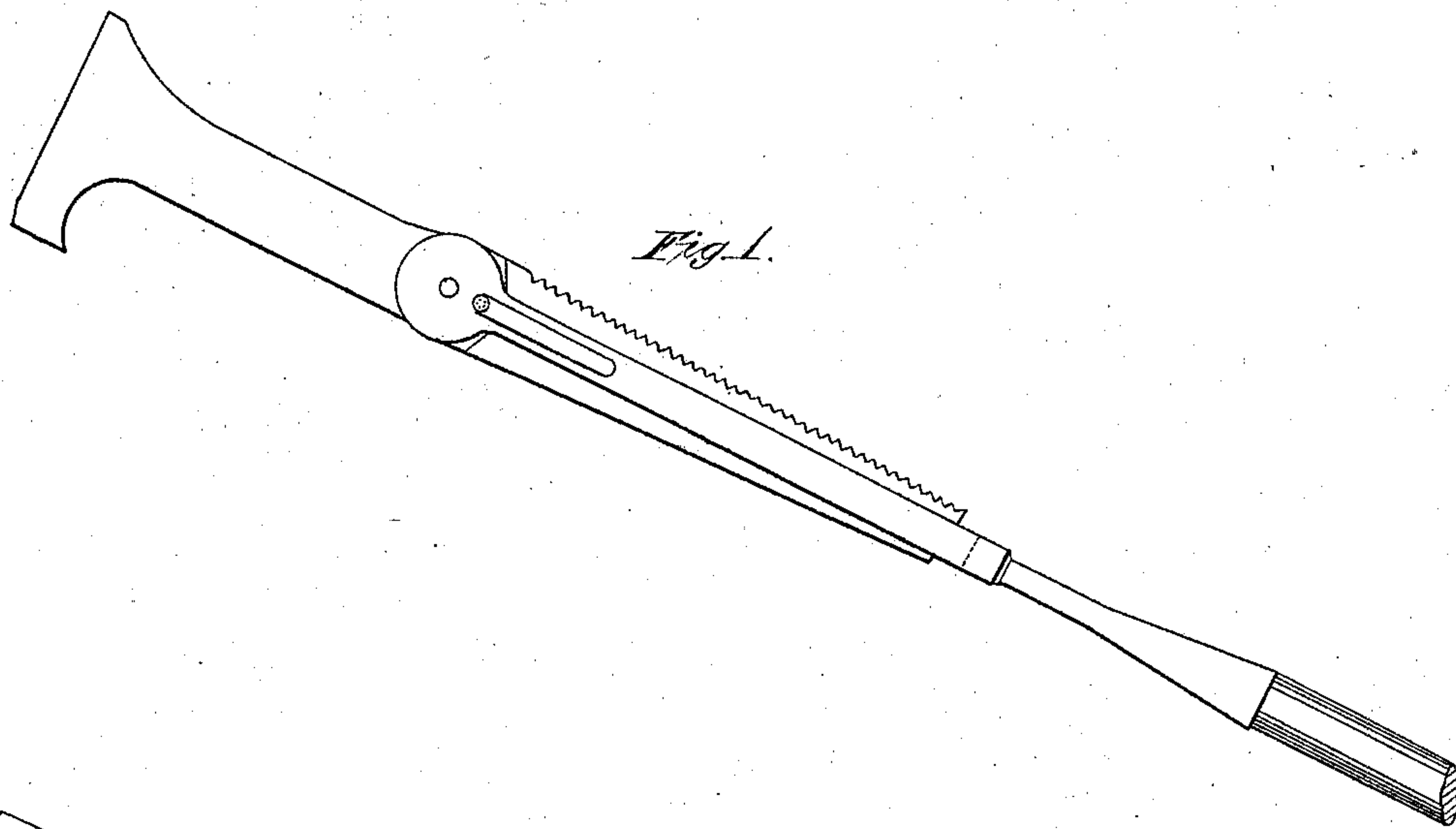

IMPROVEMENT IN PRUNING-KNIFE, HOOK, AND SAW.

The Schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Be it known that I, ROGER W. PORTER, of Nashua, county of Hillsborough, State of New Hampshire, have invented a new and improved Combination for Pruning-Hook, Knife, Chisel, and Saw; and I hereby declare that the following is a full and exact description thereof, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, and to the letters of reference marked thereon.

The nature of my invention consists in fastening by means of the pin B in a circular plate, so as to use the hook, knife, chisel, and saw in a separate manner.

What I claim as my invention, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The pruning-hook, knife, chisel, and saw, constructed and arranged as shown in combination.
