IMPROVED MEDICAL COMPOUND.

The Schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Be it known that I, DANIEL W. TAYLOR, of the county of Bell, and State of Texas, have invented or discovered a Preparation for the Destruction of Screw-Worms in Stock; and I do hereby declare that the following are the component and proportional parts of said preparation, viz: Concentrated extract tobacco, sixteen ounces; potash, eight ounces; gum-camphor, two ounces; oil turpentine, four ounces; asafoetida, two ounces; sulphur, two ounces; lard oil, four ounces; total, thirty-eight ounces.

The mode of preparation is: Dissolve the potash, camphor, and asafoetida, and mix. Place the whole in a close kettle, over a brisk fire, until it is reduced to a thin paste. It is fit for use when cool.

What I claim as my invention or discovery, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The preparation or medicine herein described, for the purpose set forth.
