IMPROVED LINIMENT, OR MEDICAL COMPOUND.

The Schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Darius C. Randall, of Niles-City, in the county of Berrien, and State of Michigan, have invented certain new and useful Improvements in Medicinal Compounds; and I do hereby declare that the following is a full, clear, and exact description thereof.

To enable others skilled in the art to make and use my invention, I will proceed to describe it.

My invention relates to medical compounds, and consists in combining or mixing various articles possessing certain medicinal properties, so as to form a new and useful medical compound.

In making my compound, I take one pint of alcohol, and to this add two drachms of the oil of origanum, two drachms of the oil of sassafras, two drachms of the oil of hemlock, two drachms of aqua ammonia, and four drachms of the tincture of guaiacum, or substantially

these proportions, and, while in a cold liquid state, thoroughly mix them.

By preserving these proportions, the mixture may be made in greater or less quantities, as desired.

For rheumatism, bruises, burns, neuralgia, &c., this compound may be used with excellent results by bathing the parts affected; and, with the addition of sugar and hot water, it may be used internally for chronic diarrhea, dysentry, flux, &c.

Having thus described my invention,

What I claim, is—

The combination of the ingredients, substantially as herein described, as a new medical compound, for the purposes set forth.
