




## IMPROVEMENT IN SASH-FASTENER.

The Schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

### *To whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, MAHLON R. MARGERUM, of the city of Trenton, State of New Jersey, have invented a Sash-Lock for the supporting and locking window-sashes at any point; and I do hereby declare that the following is a full and exact description thereof, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, and to the letters of reference marked thereon.

Letter A is the lock-case, or plate.

B B are the cam-levers, or arms.

D is the pivot.

E, the springs.

C, the eccentric.

F, the key, or crank, on the shank of which is a small stud, *g*, which passes through the slot *h* in the escutcheon I, Figure 2, and prevents the key from being withdrawn, except at the point at which the stud and slot coincide.

To raise the sash, the eccentric is turned by the key, or crank, which should be turned up. To lower the sash, the key or crank should be turned down, but wherever placed, the sash is fastened, until the crank is used to relieve it.

I do not claim the eccentric or cam-levers and the springs, as they are old and well known; but

What I do claim, is—

The sash-lock A, with the cam-levers, or arms B, spring E, in combination with key F and stud *g*, and the slot *h* in the escutcheon I, all constructed and arranged as described.
