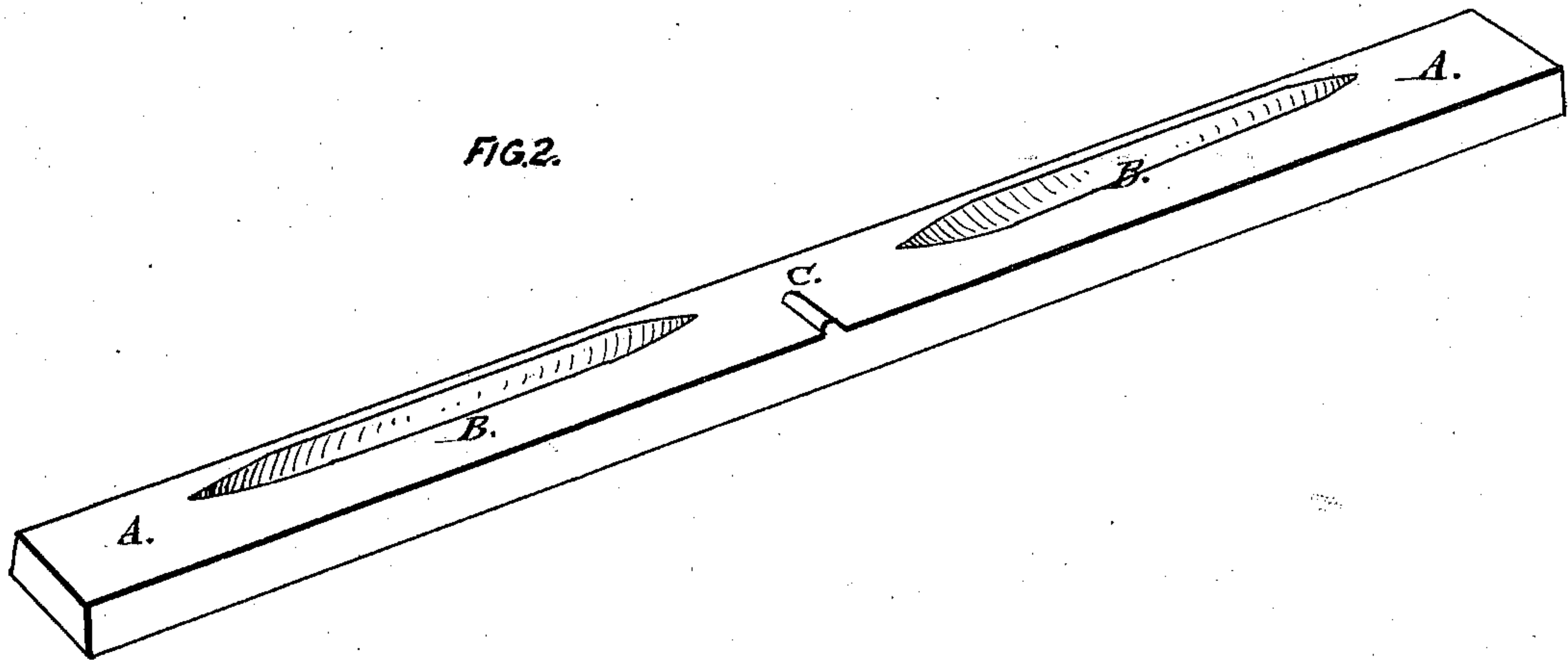
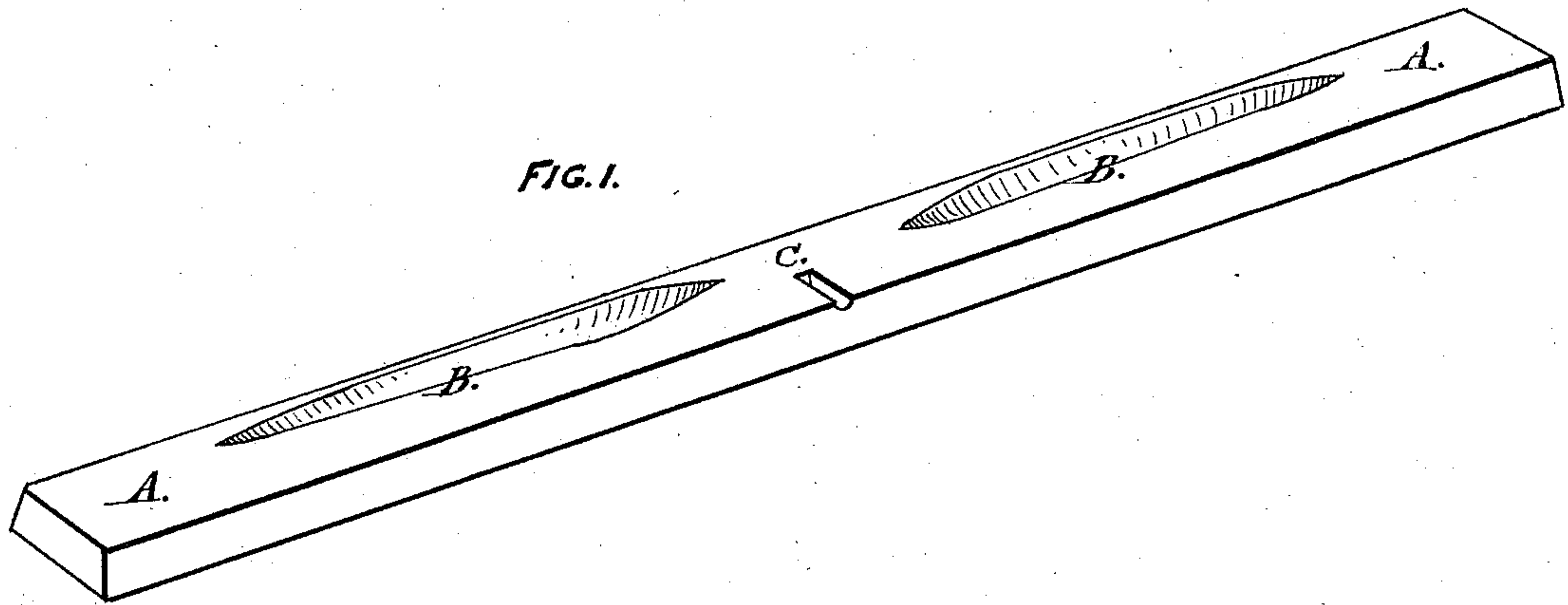

Letters Patent No. 97,327, dated November 30, 1869; antedated November 13, 1869.

IMPROVED HORSESHOE-BLANK.

The Schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

To all whom it may concern :

Be it known that I, ENOCH B. TURNER, of Providence, in the county of Providence, and State of Rhode Island, have made certain new and useful Improvements in Horseshoe-Blanks; and I do hereby declare the following to be a full and exact description thereof, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, making part of this specification.

My improvement consists in providing a bar of horseshoe-blanks with a projecting rib or notch on the inner edge of the creased surface, to mark the middle of the blank, and to indicate the point at which it is to be bent.

The figures in the accompanying drawings represent a bar containing only one horseshoe-blank.

A A is the bar;

B B, the creases; and

C, the groove or notch.

I claim, as my improvement of horseshoe-blanks—

A projecting rib or notch, placed on the inner edge of the creased surface of the blank, to mark its middle, and to indicate the point at which it is to be bent, substantially as described.
