IMPROVED NITRO-GLYCERINE COMPOUND FOR BLASTING.

Specification forming part of Letters Patent No. 98,382, dated December 28, 1869.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, John Horsley, of Cheltenham, England, have invented or discovered certain new and useful Improvements in the Manufacture of Blasting-Powder or Explosive Compounds; and I do hereby declare that the following is a full, true, and exact description thereof—that is to say:

This invention consists in the incorporation of nitro-glycerine either with a powdered mixture of Aleppo or other foreign gall-nuts and chlorate of potash, or with a mixture of powdered galls, charcoal, and chorate of potash; or with a mixture of powdered galls, cream of tartar, and chlorate of potash; or with a mixture of galls, hard sugar, and chlorate of potash, so as to form a powerful blasting-powder

or explosive compound.

The manner in which my invention may be carried into effect is as follows: I incorporate from twenty to twenty-five per cent. of pure nitro-glycerine, free from acid, with any of the following explosive mixtures or powders, the incorporation being effected by working up four fluid ounces of pure nitro-glycerine with a pound of one of the mixtures or powders in a flat dish by means of a bone or wooden spatula until the nitro-glycerine is thoroughly absorbed.

Powder A.—Best Aleppo or other foreign galls, four ounces; chlorate of potash, twelve ounces.

Powder B.—Aleppo or other foreign galls, two ounces; alder-wood or other vegetable charcoal, two ounces; chlorate of potash, twelve ounces.

Powder C.—Aleppo or other foreign galls, two ounces; cream of tartar, two ounces; chlorate of potash, twelve ounces.

Powder D.—Aleppo or other foreign galls, two ounces; hard sugar of any kind, two ounces; chlorate of potash, twelve ounces.

The proportions hereinbefore given are what I find to answer well; but it will be understood that I do not limit myself thereto.

What I claim, and desire to secure by Let-

ters Patent, is—

The manufacture of blasting-powder or explosive compounds by incorporating nitroglycerine with any of the explosive mixtures or powders herein described, and in about the proportions herein set forth.
