## IMPROVEMENT IN MEDICAL COMPOUNDS FOR TREATING HOGS.

Specification forming part of Letters Patent No. 125,492, dated April 9, 1872.

Specification describing a new and Improved Medical Compound, invented by JOHN SHANNON, of Palmyra, in the county of Marion and State of Missouri.

My invention has for its object to furnish an improved medical compound for hogs; and it consists in the compound formed of the ingredients in the proportions hereinafter described.

In preparing this compound I take sulphur, four hundred and twenty-six and two-thirds grains; copperas, four hundred and twenty-six and two-thirds grains; alum, four hundred and twenty-six and two-thirds grains; salt-peter, two hundred and thirteen and one-third grains; resin, two hundred and thirteen and one-third grains; fenugreek, two hundred and thirteen and one-third grains; precipitate sul-

phur of antimony, one hundred and six and two-thirds grains; assafoetida, one hundred and six and two-thirds grains; soot, fourteen hundred and ninety-three and one-third grains; and salt, twenty-one hundred and ninety-three and one-third grains.

These ingredients are pulverized and thoroughly mixed with each other, and are then ready for use.

Having thus described my invention, I claim as new and desire to secure by Letters Patent—

The medical compound, prepared of the ingredients in the proportions and manner substantially as herein described and set forth.
