

IMPROVEMENT IN SMOKING-TUBES.

Specification forming part of Letters Patent No. 140,360, dated July 1, 1873; application filed March 28, 1873.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, August Gedies, of New York, in the State of New York, have invented certain Improvements in Smoking-Tubes, of which the following is a specification:

This invention consists in the arrangement of a tube or casing over the smoking-tube, which contains the tobacco, for the purpose of preventing the ashes from falling out.

In the accompanying drawing, which represents a longitudinal section, B represents the mouth-piece. A, a plug inserted into the forward end of the mouth-piece, on which the smoking-tube C is attached, which said tube C is filled with the tobacco to be smoked. The plug A is provided with a ring, n, of cork or other elastic substance, in the usual manner, to prevent the breaking of the mouth-piece, and upon this elastic ring n, a tube or casing, D, is placed, inclosing the smoking-tube C. This casing D has only a small opening, v, on its forward end, and several small holes,

s, near the after end, to admit the required amount of air to the inner side and to the smoking-tube.

The tobacco filled into the smoking-tube C is first lighted, after which the tube or casing D is placed over the same, whereby all ashes resulting from the smoked tobacco will be prevented from falling out.

Instead of the smoking-tube C a cigar may be placed in the recess or cavity a in the plug A, and then, when the same is lit, this case D placed over the same, so as to prevent thereby the burnt ashes from falling off.

What I claim as my invention, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The combination, with the mouth-piece B, of the plug A, having chamber a and elastic ring n, smoking-tube C, and casing D, with ventilating-holes v and s s, substantially as and for the purposes herein set forth.
