IMPROVEMENT IN THE TREATMENT OF COD-LIVER OIL.

Specification forming part of Letters Patent No. 152,746, dated July 7, 1874; application filed May 19, 1874.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Jean G. Hava, of the city of New Orleans, parish of Orleans and State of Louisiana, have invented or discovered a certain new and useful Improvement in the Treatment of Cod-Liver Oil, of which the following is a specification:

This invention consists of a solution of various proportions of gelatinous tribasic phosphate of lime in cod-liver oil by means of a current of carbonic-acid gas passed through the mixture of the gelatinous tribasic phosphate of lime and cod-liver oil, under different degrees of pressure, according to the quan-

tity of tribasic phosphate of lime required to be dissolved. This solution can be used either simple or compounded by any addition of other chemically-compatible medical substances.

Having described my invention, what I claim, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The treatment of cod-liver oil, as above described and set forth.
