

IMPROVEMENT IN PAPER BOXES.

Specification forming part of Letters Patent No. 189,037, dated April 3, 1877; application filed January 24, 1877.

To all whom it may concern.

Be it known that I, Lorenzo P. Heath, of Springfield, in the county of Hampden and State of Massachusetts, have invented a new and useful Improvement in Paper Boxes, which improvement is fully set forth in the following specification and accompanying drawing, in which—

A is the main box; B, a vertically-lifting cover; D, an auxiliary box, constructed on the top of cover B; and E, an ordinary swinging cover, hinged on one side of box D.

This box is one of the kind known as "papeterie"-boxes; and the object of my invention is to provide, by auxiliary box D and cover E, a suitable and additional receptacle for fancy paper, valentines, or other articles,

while the main box A is devoted to the keeping of other descriptions of paper or envelopes.

Auxiliary box D is constructed by attaching the side strips eeee to the top of cover B, the top of the latter forming the bottom of box D.

What I claim as my invention is—

The combination of the auxiliary box D, the hinged cover E, and the vertically-lifting cover B, with the main box A, substantially as and for the purpose set forth.
