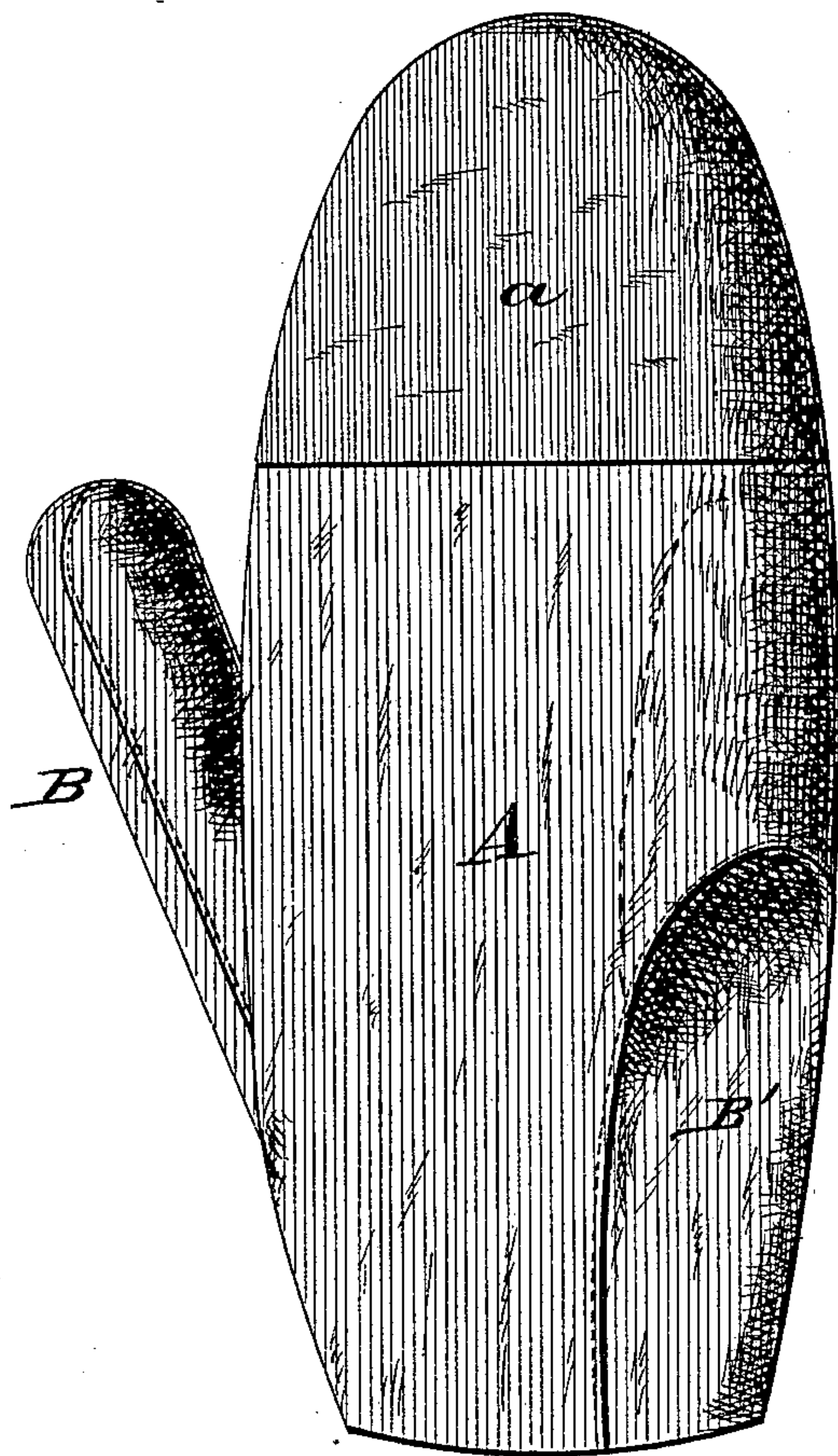
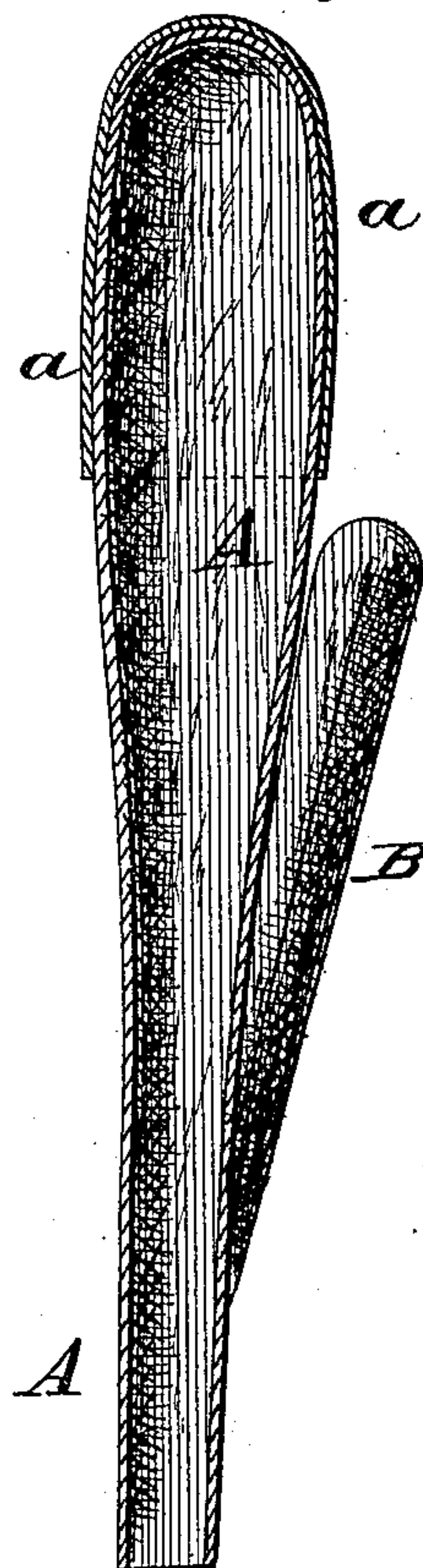

KNUD TYSDAL, OF LEE, ILLINOIS.

MITTEN.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Letters Patent No. 250,768, dated December 13, 1881.

Application filed September 17, 1881. (Model.)

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, KNUD TYSDAL, of Lee, in the county of Lee and State of Illinois, have invented certain new and useful Improvements in Mittens; and I do hereby declare that the following is a full, clear, and exact description of the invention, which will enable others skilled in the art to which it appertains to make and use the same, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, which form a part of this specification, and in which—

Figure 1 is a perspective view of my improved reversible mitten, and Fig. 2 is a sectional view of the same.

This invention has relation to improvements in mittens, its object being to render the mitten more durable, or capable of being worn longer; and it consists in a reversible mitten adapted to be reversed back for front, substantially as hereinafter more fully set forth.

To carry out my invention I employ, as will be observed by reference to the accompanying drawings, a mitten, A, made preferably by giving the tip portion a double thickness, as at *a*, for warmth and increased wear.

The essential and characteristic feature of my mitten consists in providing it with two

thumb-stalls, B B', one arranged upon each side thereof, as clearly shown. This arrangement enables the mitten to be reversed back for the front, by which its durability is promoted, or it can be worn longer—just twice the length of time as the ordinary mitten.

It is readily seen that while one stall, B, is in use, the other, B', can be reversed, turning it inside of the mitten, and thus concealing it from view, and vice versa.

Having thus fully described my invention, I claim and desire to secure by Letters Patent—

1. The herein-described reversible mitten, having upon each side a thumb-stall, substantially as and for the purpose set forth.

2. The mitten having its tip portion of double thickness, as at *a*, and provided with the stalls B B', one arranged upon each side thereof, substantially as set forth.
