




## STRAW BRAID.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Letters Patent No. 272,229, dated February 13, 1883.

Application filed September 27, 1882. (No model.)

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, HERRMAN FRIEND, of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented certain new and useful Improvements 5 in Straw Braid, of which the following is a specification.

This invention has reference to an improved ornamental straw braid for ladies' hats, waistbelts, hat-bands, and other articles; and the ro invention consists of a straw braid which is covered by an open braiding of plain or ornamental threads.

In the accompanying drawings, Figures 1, 2, and 3 represent side views of my improved 15 straw braid braided in different designs.

Similar letters of reference indicate corresponding parts.

A in the drawings represents a straw braid of flat or other shape and of any desired width. 20 This straw braid is covered on a braiding-machine of any approved construction with six, eight, or more threads, BB', which intermesh in such a manner as to form an open ornamental braiding over the straw braid A.

By using chenille, silk, or other ornamental cords B' in braiding, and plain binding off threads B, of silk or other material, a very or-

namental appearance is imparted to the straw braid. A variety of designs may be produced thereby, which render the straw, when so cov- 30 ered by braided threads, applicable to a number of fancy articles for summer use.

The straw employed for the straw braid or body A is preferably of the usual yellow color, as the different colors of the threads braided 35 over the same appear thereon to better advantage.

Having thus described my invention, I claim as new and desire to secure by Letters Patent-

1. As a new article of manufacture, a straw to braid provided with an open-meshed braiding of suitable threads, substantially as set forth.

2. As a new article of manufacture, a straw braid provided with an open-meshed braiding of plain and ornamental threads or cords, sub- 45 stantially as specified.
