HARNESS OR HAME LINK.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Letters Patent No. 277,290, dated May 8, 1883.

Application filed January 5, 1883. (No model.)

To all whom it may concern :

Be it known that I, JOHN J. KELLY, a citizen of the United States, residing at Newark, in the county of Essex and State of New Jersey, have invented certain new and useful Improvements in Harness or Hame Dog-Links; and I do hereby declare the following to be a full, clear, and exact description of the invention, such as will enable others skilled in the art to which it appertains to make and use the same, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, and to letters of reference marked thereon, which form a part of this specification.

15 The object of this invention is to reduce the cost of constructing hame-links and provide a durable and superior article at the price of one much inferior in quality.

20 The invention consists in the improved article of manufacture, constructed and arranged substantially as will be herein set forth, and finally embodied in the claim.

25 The accompanying drawings, of which Figure 1 is a side elevation, and Fig. 2 a plan, of my device, illustrate the nature of my invention,

tion, *a* being the body of the link, having each extremity thereof hooked to engage with the hame, and *b* a loop portion forming a link-eye, each extremity thereof being secured by riveting into perforations *c* in the body portion, as shown. 30

The link thus constructed can be made from wrought-iron at a great reduction in the price of wrought-iron links now in the market, all the strength and finish being retained. 35

Having thus described my invention, what I claim is—

The improved hame-link, composed of the body portion *a*, having hooked extremities and perforated to receive the extremities of the loop portion *b*, and said loop portion having the extremities thereof secured in said perforations, substantially as herein set forth. 40
