

THOMAS HEATHCOTE, OF ALLEGHENY CITY, PENNSYLVANIA.

STONE-LIFTER.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Letters Patent No. 314,243, dated March 24, 1885.

Application filed October 18, 1884. (No mod. l.)

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, THOMAS HEATHCOTE, a citizen of the United States, residing at Allegheny City, in the county of Allegheny and 5 State of Pennsylvania, have made an Improvement in Lewis Tools; and I do hereby declare the following to be a correct description of the same, reference being had to the drawings hereto annexed.

Figure 1 is a front view of my improved stone-lifter. Fig. 2 is a side elevation of the same.

Referring to the drawings, a is a cone-shaped plug, provided at one end with a suitable eye, b, in which is placed an ordinary ring, c, to which power is applied when the lifter is in use. On each side of the cone-shaped plug a, and connected together by means of slotted links d d', are two ribbed feathers, e 20 e', constructed so as to fit closely against the sides of the cone-shaped plug a. The slotted links d d' are intended to hold the feathers e

e' by means of suitable bolts, as shown in Fig. 1 of the drawings.

It will be apparent that when the lifter, as 25 shown, with the feathers e e' in proper position, is placed in an oblong hole, and power is applied by means of the ring e to the plug e, the plug e will be forced upwardly, forcing the ribbed feathers outwardly and against the 30 sides of the oblong hole.

Having thus briefly described my invention, what I claim, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The herein-described stone-lifter, consisting 35 of the cone-shaped plug a, with the ring c, and slotted links d d', with the ribbed feathers e e', as shown and described, and for the purposes intended.
