SALVE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Letters Patent No. 334,028, dated January 12, 1886.

Application filed September 28, 1885. Serial No. 178,458. (Specimens.)

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ANTON MEYER, a citizen of the United States, residing at Empire City, in the county of Ormsby and State of Nevada, have invented a new and useful composition of matter or salve to be used for the healing of wounds, burns, bruises, and sores of any kind whatsoever, of which the following is a specification.

10 My composition consists of the following ingredients, combined in the proportions stated, namely: six ounces hog's fat; three ounces beeswax; five ounces fir-balsam; one ounce

camphor; one-half ounce alcohol; one-half ounce arnica.

What I claim, and desire to secure by Letters Patent of the United States, is—

The herein-described composition of matter to be used for the healing of burns, bruises, &c., consisting of hog's lard, beeswax, fir-balsam, camphor, arnica, and alcohol, in the proportions specified.
