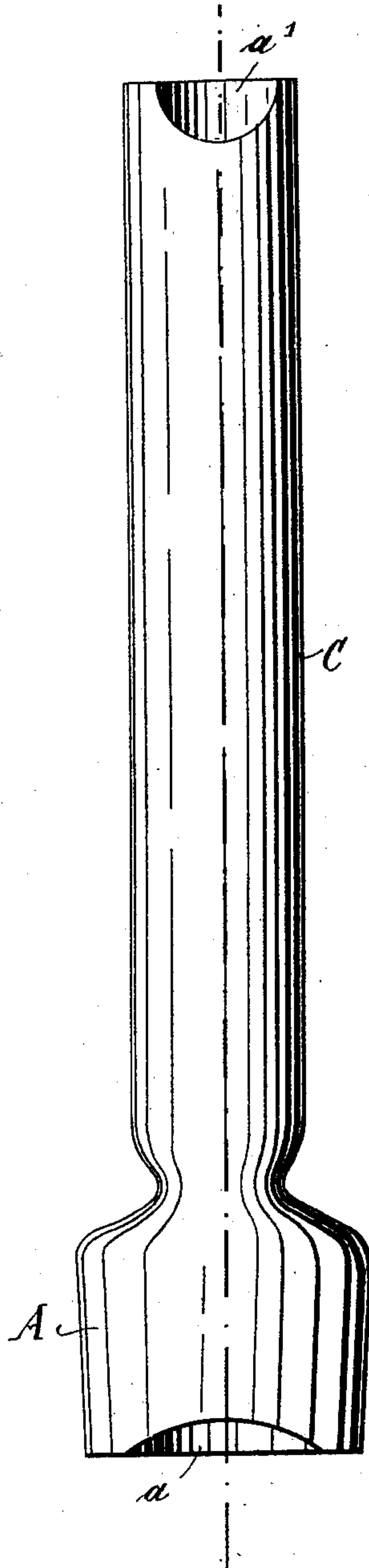

## LAMP-CHIMNEY.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Letters Patent No. 363,544, dated May 24, 1887.

Application filed March 27, 1886. Serial No. 196,760. (No model.)

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, FRIEDRICH WILHELM ROSENOW, of Reppen, near Frankfort-on-the-Main, in the Empire of Germany, have invented certain new and useful Improvements in Lamp-Chimneys, of which the following is a specification.

The object of my invention is to provide a chimney so constructed as to facilitate the extinguishing of the light by blowing over the top of said chimney.

The invention consists of a chimney having a notch in its upper end.

In the accompanying drawing a side view of a chimney provided with my improvement is shown.

C is the chimney, which is provided at its upper end with a notch, *a'*, to permit of blowing at right angles to the longitudinal axis of

the chimney for the purpose of extinguishing the light without danger of explosion. The air that enters the notch strikes the opposite side of the chimney and is guided upward, thereby causing a draft which extinguishes the light.

Having thus described my invention, I claim as new and desire to secure by Letters Patent—

A lamp-chimney having a single notch in its upper edge at one side only, substantially as shown and described.
