

## PIPE-TONGS.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Letters Patent No. 497,797, dated May 23, 1893.

Application filed March 24, 1893. Serial No. 467,475. (No model.)

To all whom it may concern:

Beitknown that I, ROBERT CHARLES JONES, a citizen of the United States, residing at Mars, in the county of Butler and State of Pennsyl-5 vania, have invented certain new and useful Improvements in Pipe-Tongs; and I do hereby declare the following to be a full, clear, and exact description of the invention, such as will enable others skilled in the art to which to it pertains to make and use the same, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, which form a part of this specification.

My invention relates to an improved pipe wrench, and consists in certain details of con-15 struction, and combination of parts as will be

fully described hereinafter.

In the accompanying drawings Figure is a side elevation of my improved pipe wrench, which is constructed in accordance with my 20 invention. Fig. 2 is a side elevation of the slotted gripping tongs, separated from the clamp.

To put my invention into practice I provide a bar of metal 1, for a handle, having 25 a sharpened edge 4 at one end thereof and slightly curve the said end to fit neatly about the pipe 5. Arranged in a recess in this forward end of the bar 1 is a removable triangular piece of steel 3, which together l

with the sharp edge 4 will take a firm hold 30 of the pipe 5 when held by the clamping jaw 7. Formed in the bar 1 at a suitable point is a slot 2 through which the pivot 6 of the jaw 7 is passed. By thus pivoting the jaw 7 in the manner described, large and small pipes may 35 be operated on, and the said slot 2 permits the said bar 1 to move forward to engage the sharp edge 4 and the removable triangular piece 3 with the pipe 5, as shown in dotted lines on the drawings.

Having thus described my invention, what I claim, and desire to secure by Letters Pat-

ent, is—

The herein described pipe wrench, consisting of the bar 1 having the sharpened edge 4 45 and curved portion to fit neatly about the pipe, the removable triangular piece 3, the slot 2 formed in the said bar 1, the clamping jaw 7, and the pivot 6, all arranged and combined for service, substantially as and for 50 the purpose described.
