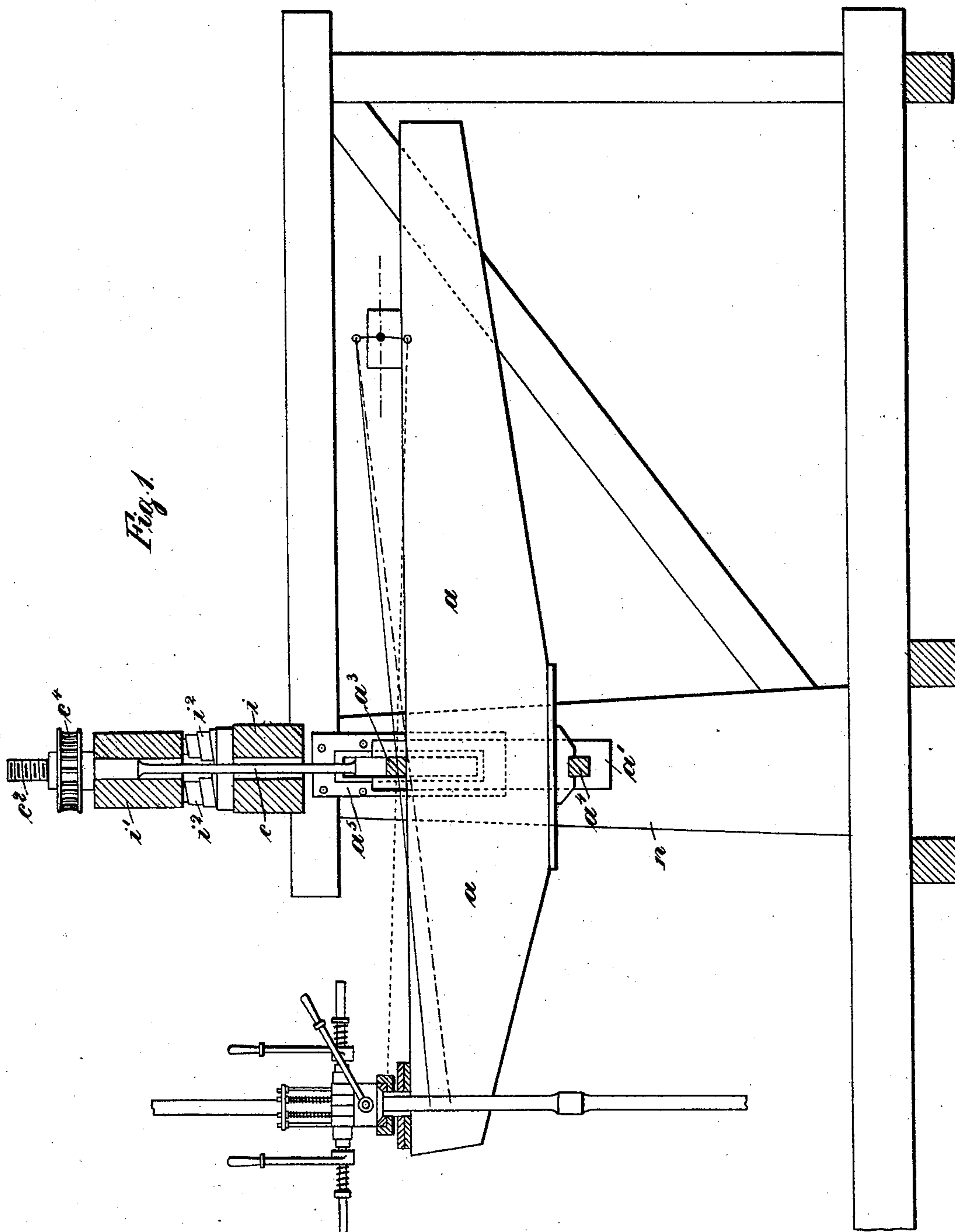

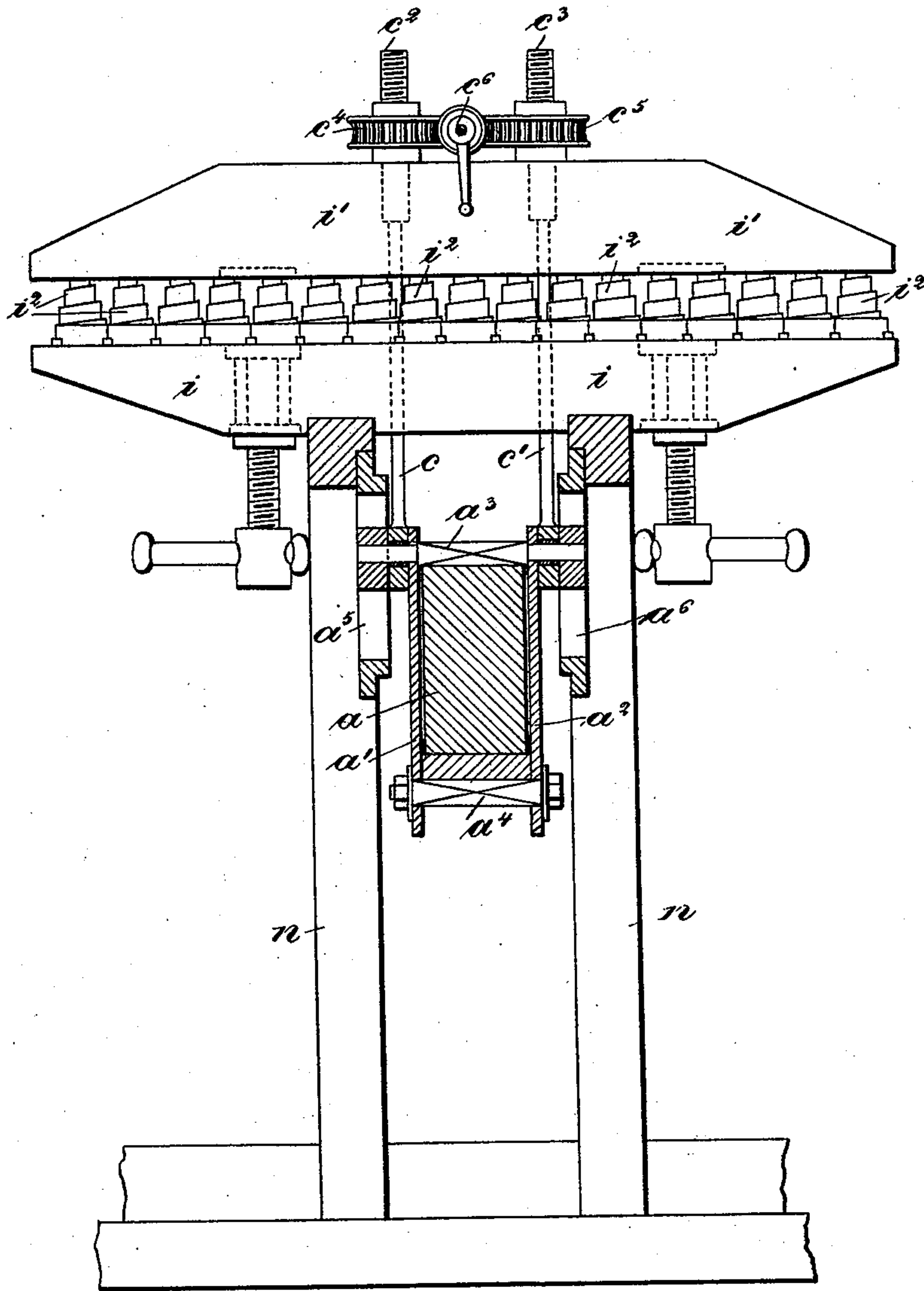

Having now particularly described and ascertained the nature of this invention, what I desire to secure by Letters Patent of the United States is—

5 In a boring apparatus for deep borings having an oscillating beam supported by springs, the combination with the latter and with their support, of another support for said oscillating beam; said other support be-
10 ing carried by said springs, and means for

changing the distance between the said beam and the said supports, for the purpose as described.
