FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of the new design;

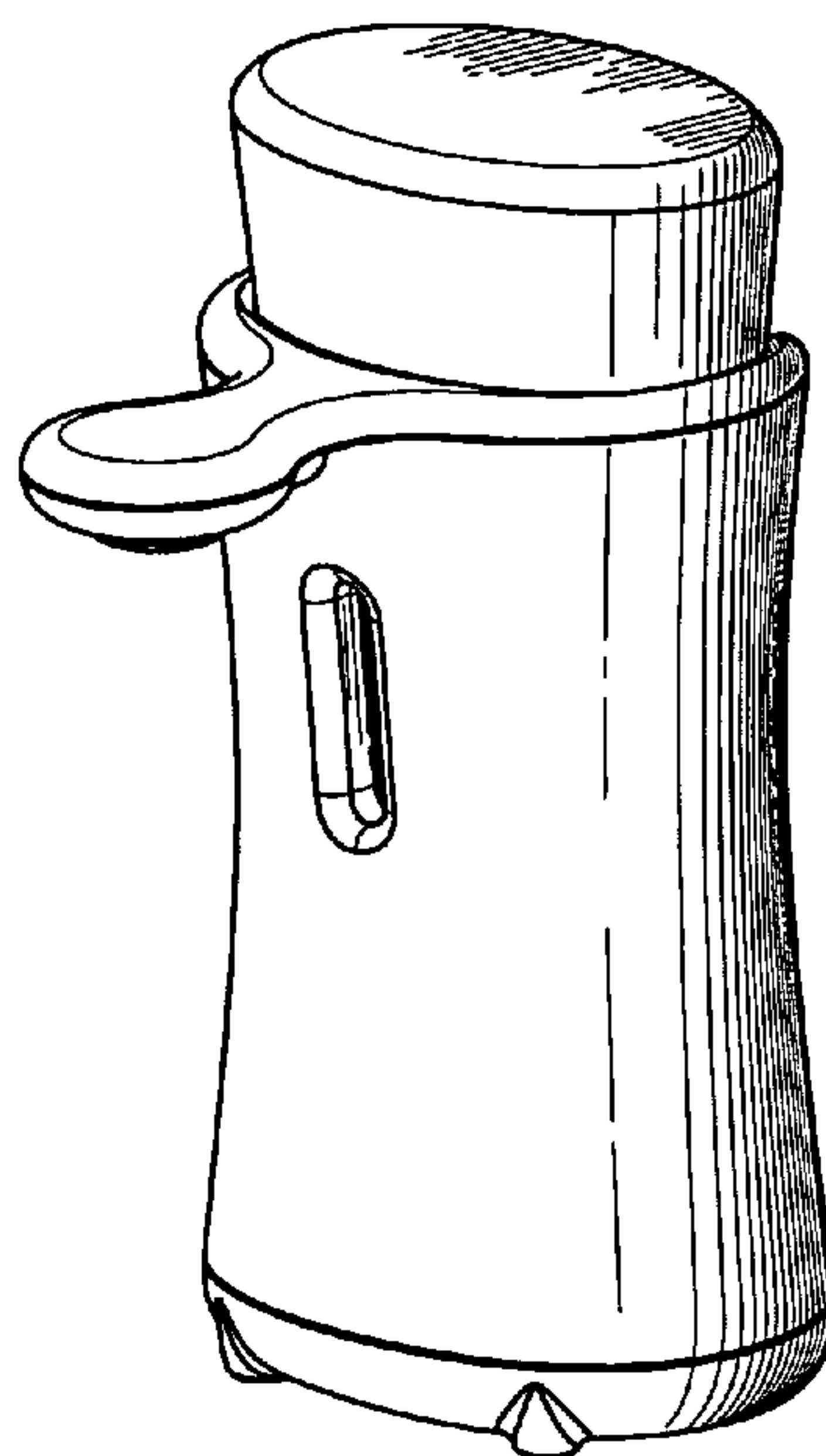
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view of the new design;

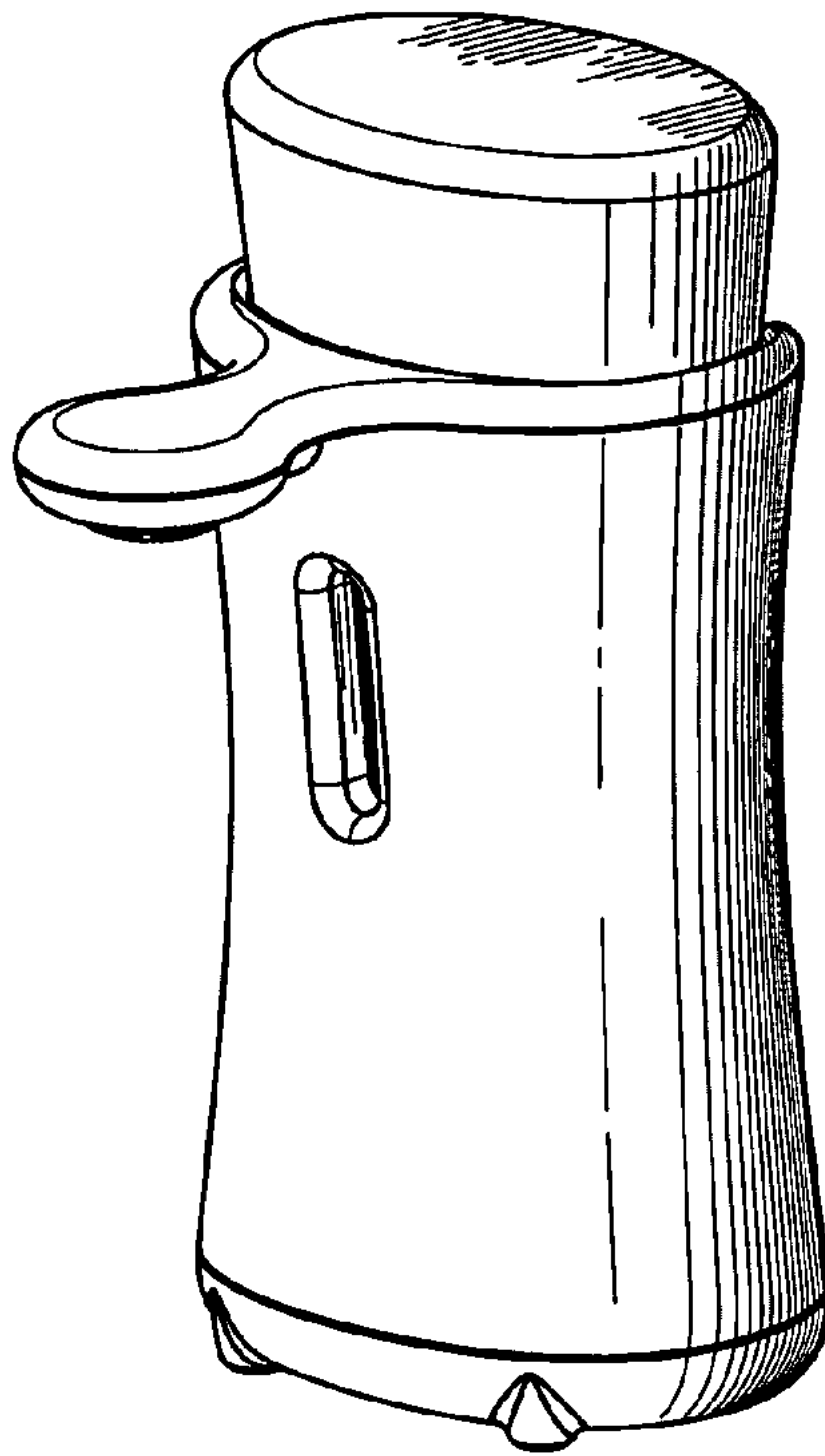

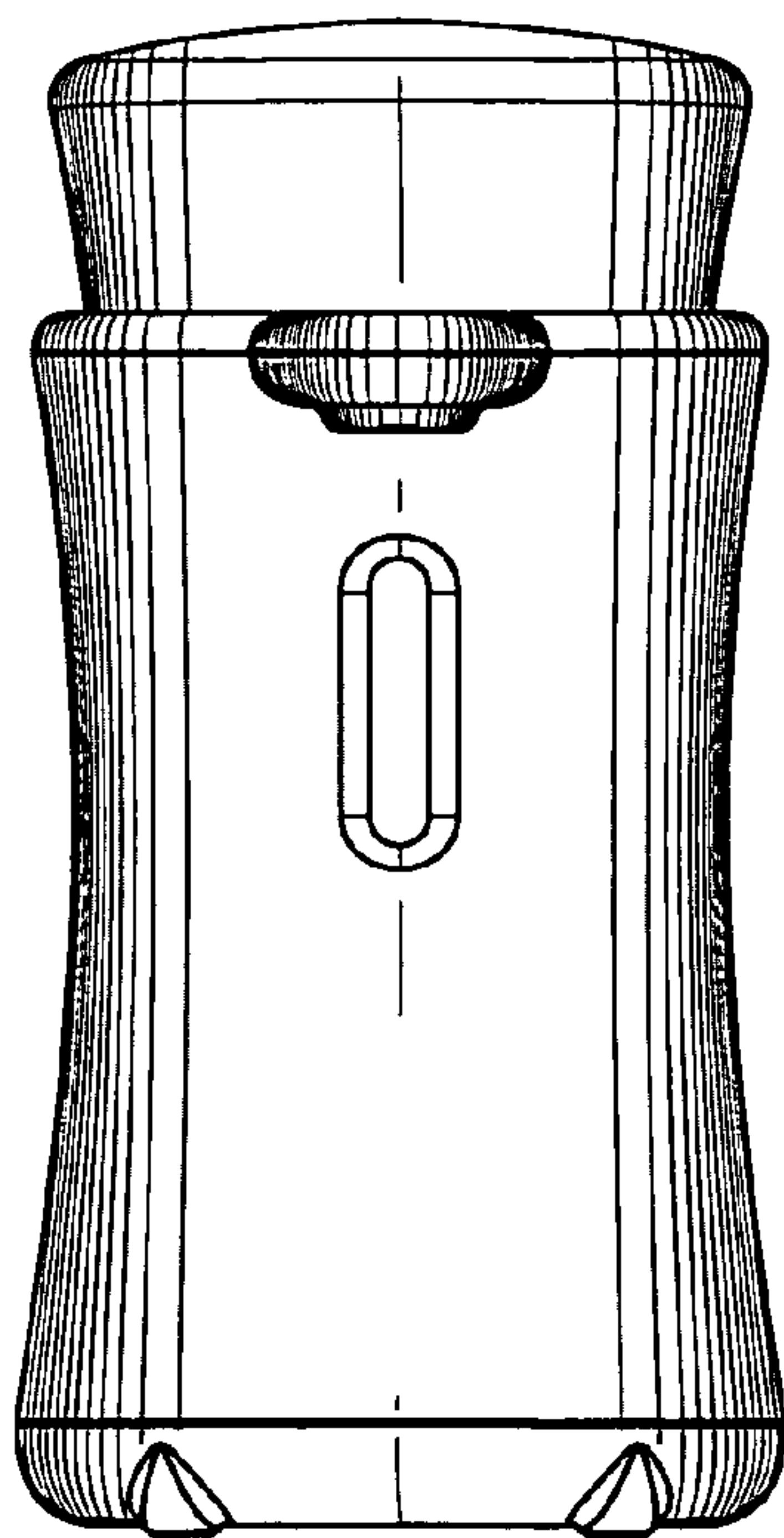

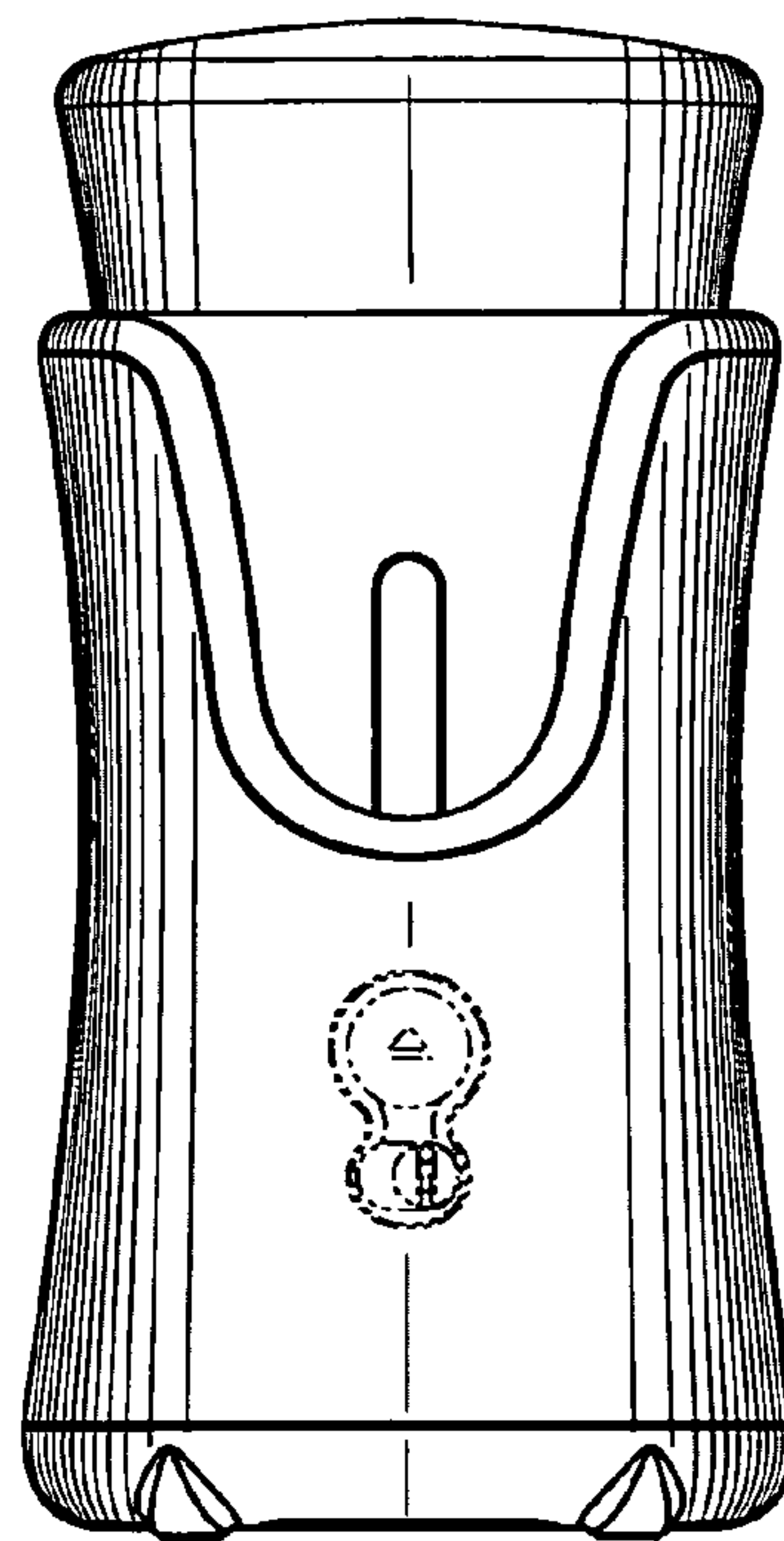

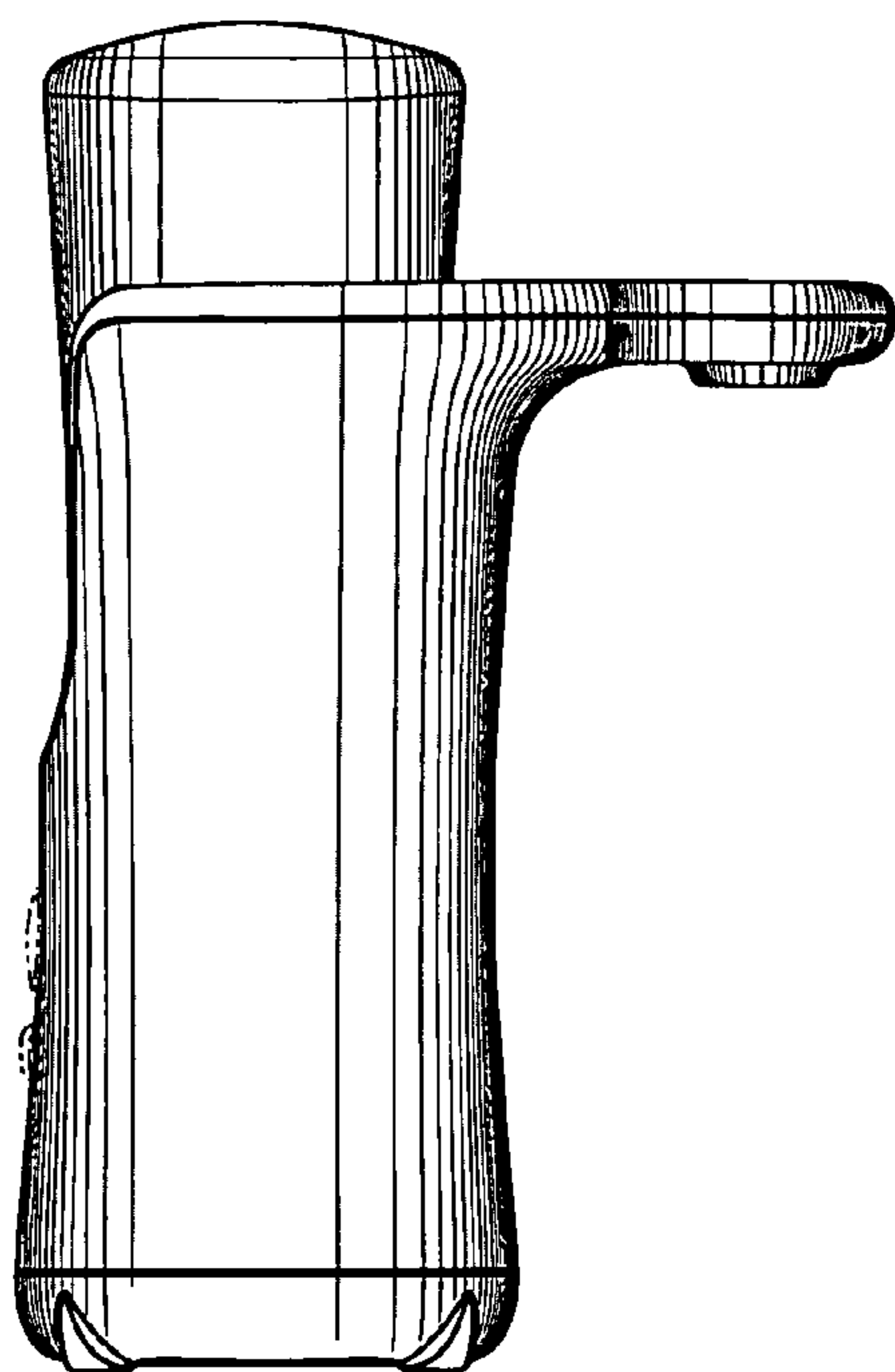

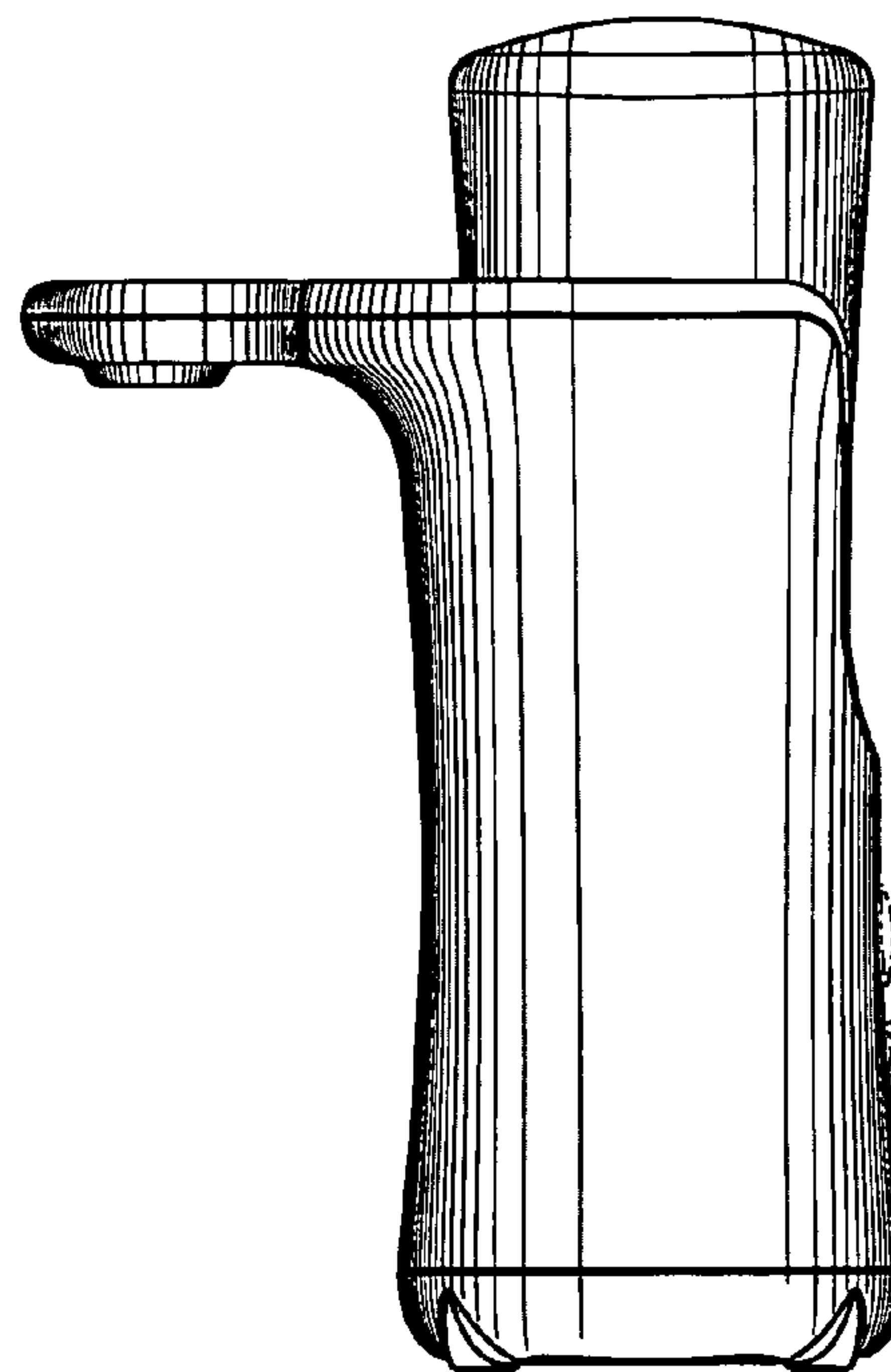

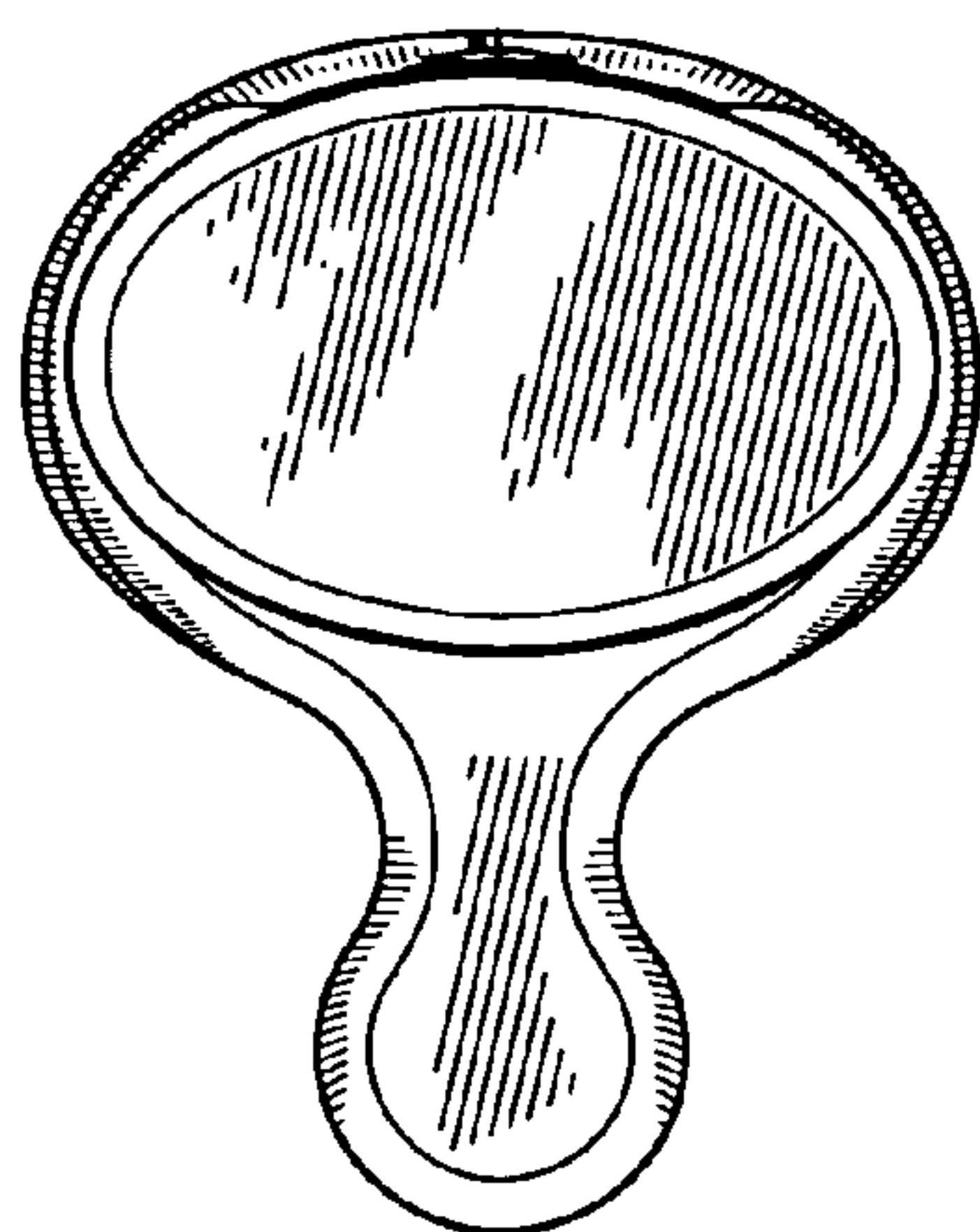

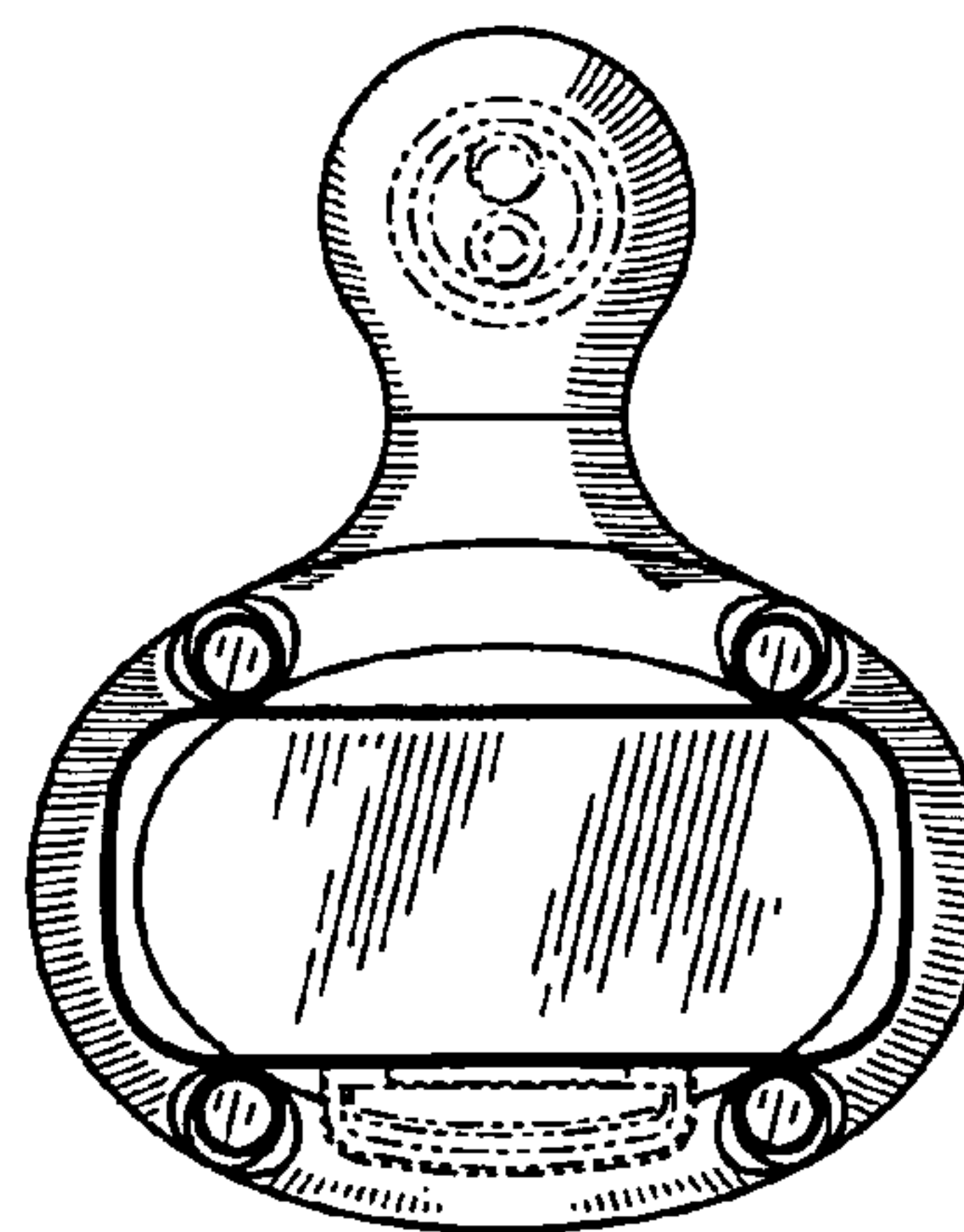
