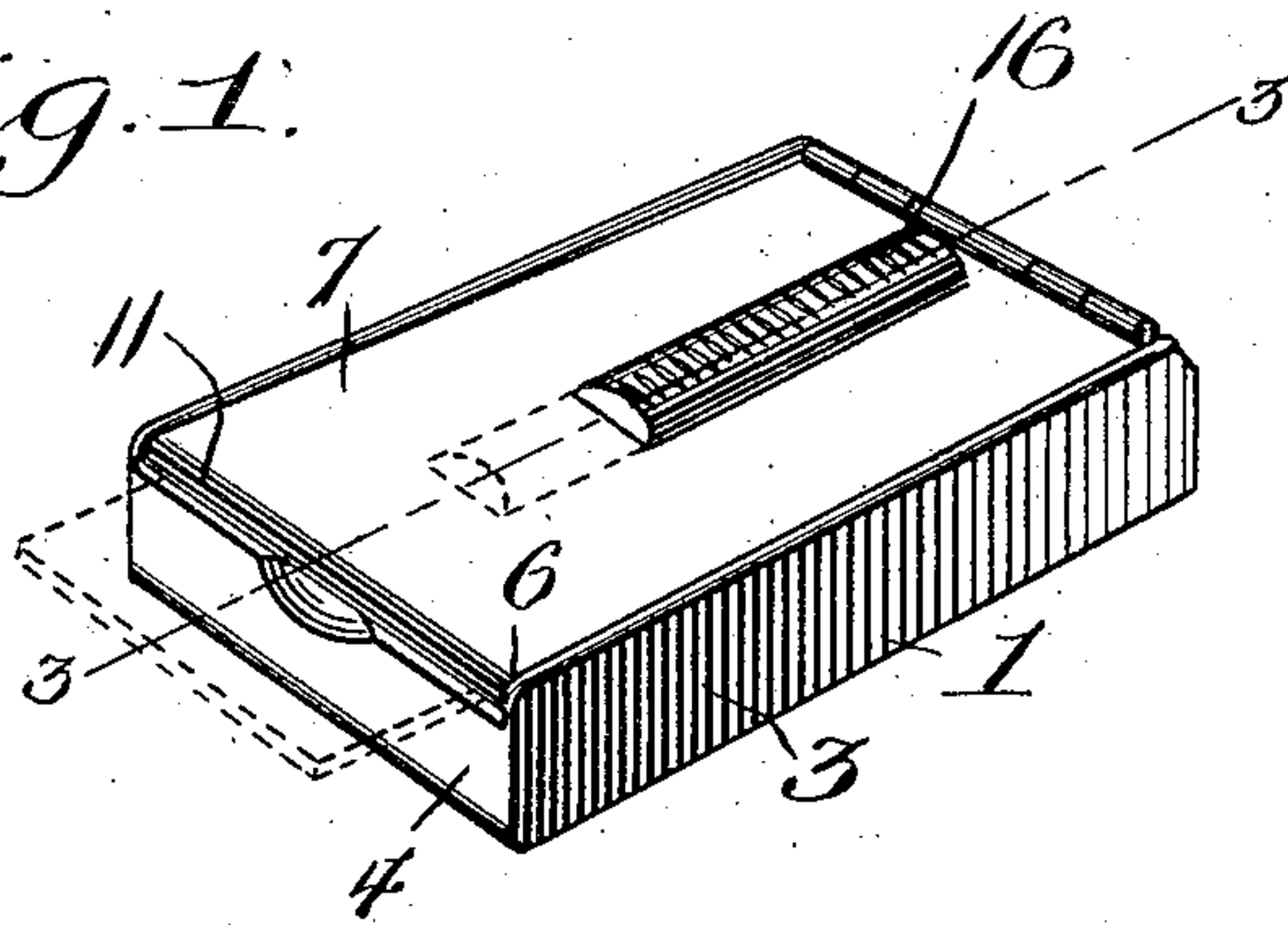

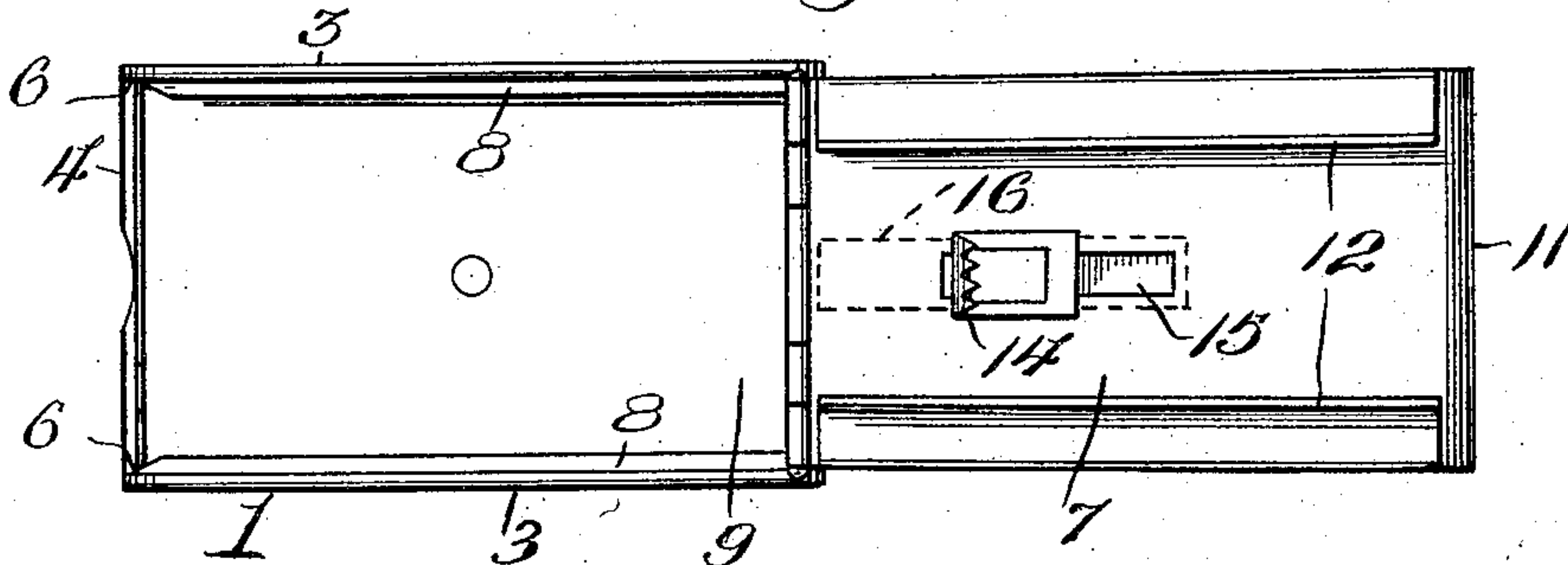

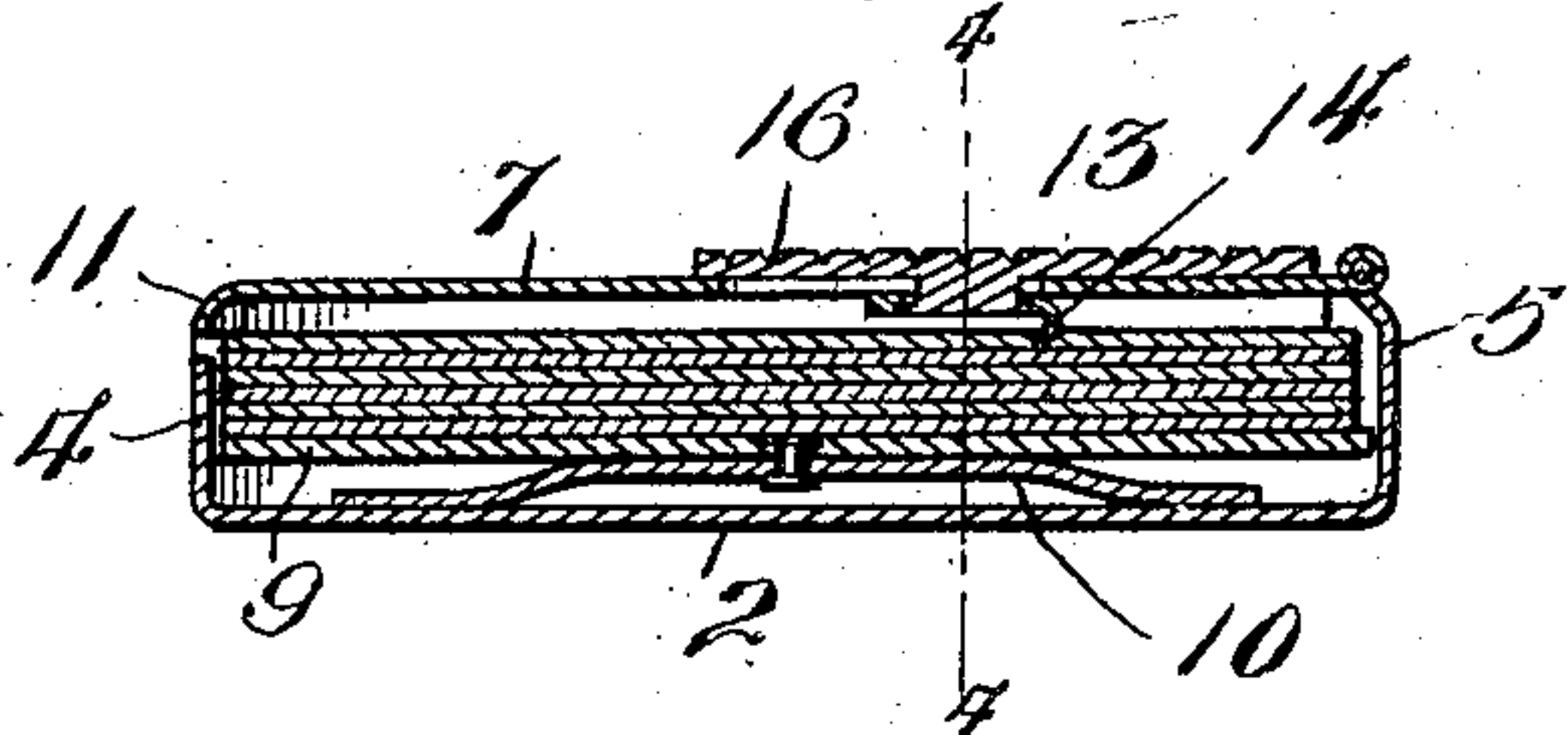
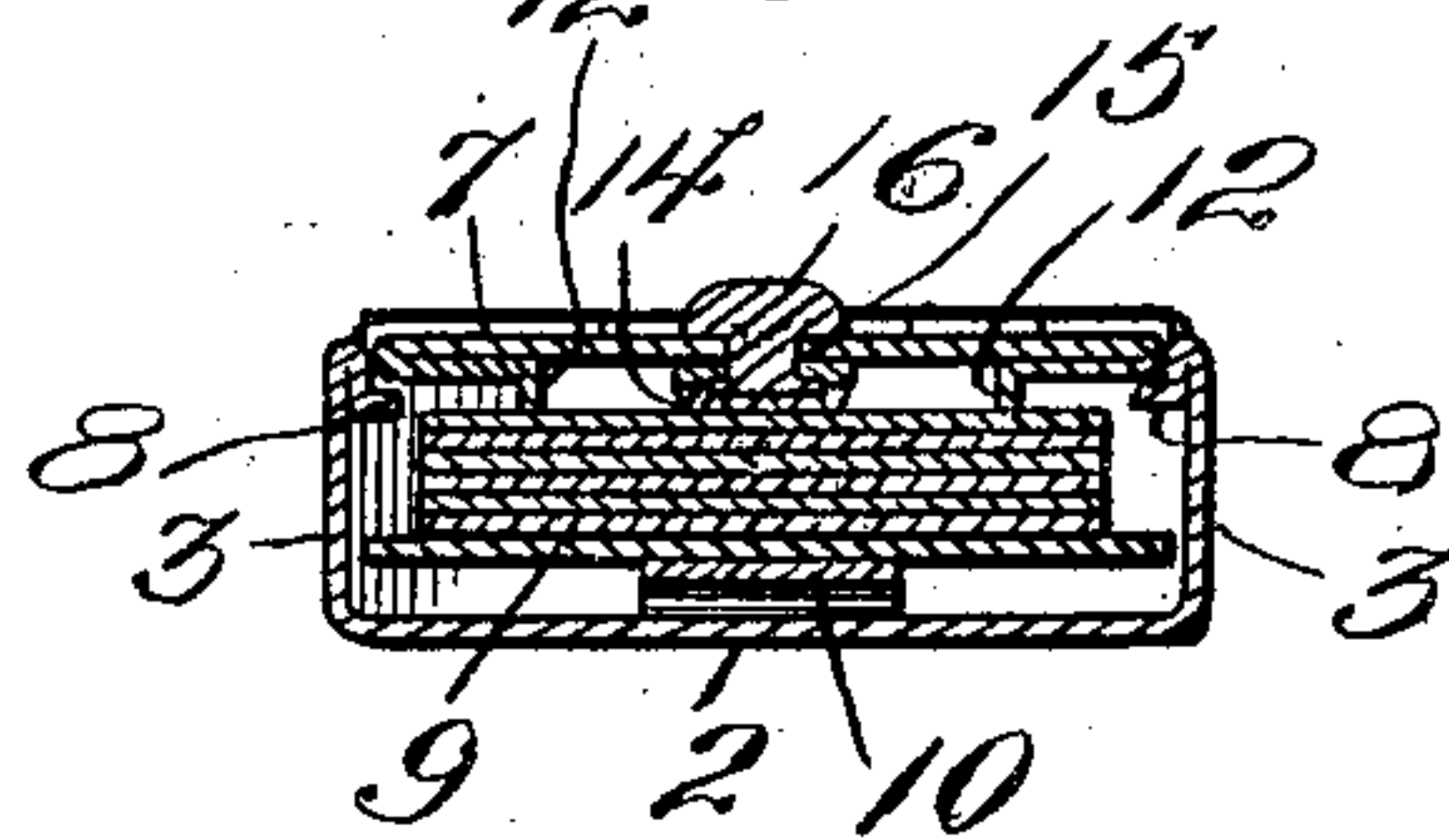

Be it known that I, KJARTAU BLEKASTAD, a citizen of the United States, residing at Seattle, in the county of King and State of Washington, have invented new and useful Improvements in Ticket-Holders, of which the following is a specification.

My invention relates to car ticket holders of the character, which is embodied in the accompanying drawings, and which

ejector 13. This ejector 13 comprises a toothed member 14, adapted for engagement with the cards; and having a reduced upwardly projecting portion adapted to be engaged between the walls of a longitudinal cut away portion 15 provided by the top head 16, by which the ejector is operated. From the above description it will be noted that the device constructed in accordance with the present invention is extremely simple and thoroughly effective in operation, and a card can be ejected at a time during the engagement by the ejector 13 with the cards.

From the above description it will be noted that the device constructed in accordance with the present invention is extremely simple and thoroughly effective in operation, but a single card can be ejected at a time and that the card engaged by the ejector is not mutilated or defaced during the operation. It is to be noted that the finger of the ejector are rounded toward the top of the box, so that when a card is projected through the opening between lip 11 of the top 7 and the front wall the receptacle without danger of finger engagement by the teeth.
