Patent is,

1. A night-gown consisting of a body portion, and a plurality of feet protectors forming a part of and projecting in front and 70 below the lower end of the gown.

2. In a night-gown, a mody formed of a back and front portion separated at the lower ends, a strip secured at the bottom of the front portion, and a plurality of indi- 75 vidual feet protectors secured to and extending in front from beneath said strip.
