

In a similar has had the effect of greatly reducing the demand for a one-piece or combination outer work garment, or the so-called coveralls. My invention remedies this defect by provid-50 ing the inside elastic straps interposed between the shoulders and waist line of the garment, whereby the back may be fully bloused so that the shrinkage occurring in a garment can be compensated for by said straps, at the same time providing a more comfortable garment in which the wearer may readily bend

I have shown an outer A further object of the invention resides garment indicated in its entirety at A, which comprises a trouser portion 10 and a coat por- 65 tion 11. The trouser portion 10 is formed with legs 12 and 13 and is provided at its upper edge with a waist band 14 extending completely around the same. The coat portion 11 is provided with a front 15 and a back 16 70 having attached to them a neck band 17 and sleeves 18 and 19.
