




An article of jewelry comprising an ornament in the form of a container having open-5 ings therein, means to detachably secure the lower end of the container to the front of a garment at the top of the latter, chains having their inner ends secured to the top

Having described the invention what is of the container, and means at the outer ends of the chains for detachable connection with 10 the shoulder straps of a garment to support said container in upright position and hold said shoulder straps in place.
