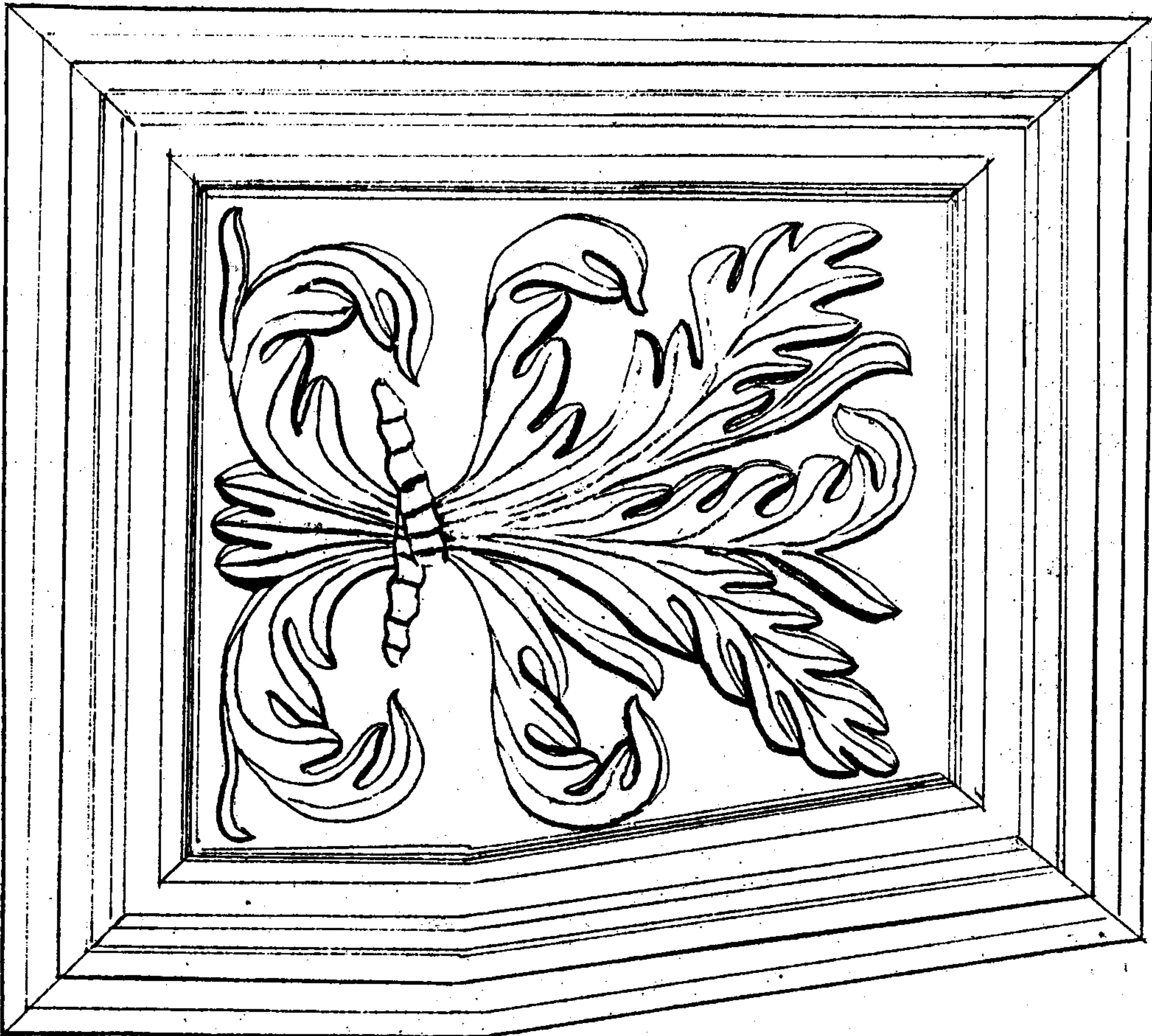

The Schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Reuben J. Blanchard of the City and County of Albany and State of New York, have invented or produced a new and original design for the plates of a cast iron stove: (which I call the Albany Cooking Stove) And I do hereby declare that the following is a full and exact description of the same.

Fig. 1. in the drawings is the door of the stove, the sides of which are ornamented and strengthened with heavy mouldings, and the centre of which is ornamented with a design representing a bunch of leaves tied together with a band or ribbon.

Fig. 2. represents one side of the foot of the stove, the other side being similar, and standing at right angles to the side represented in the drawing. This foot is ornamented with a leaf as seen in Fig. 2. The other side of the foot is ornamented in a similar and corresponding manner.

This door and foot being the only ornamented parts of the stove, the remainder of the stove is not represented in the drawings.

I do not claim the mouldings around the door as seen in Fig. 1. but what I do claim as my invention and desire to secure by Letters Patent is the bunch of leaves tied together as seen in Fig. 1, and the leaf ornament in Fig. 2; as such a design as above mentioned.
