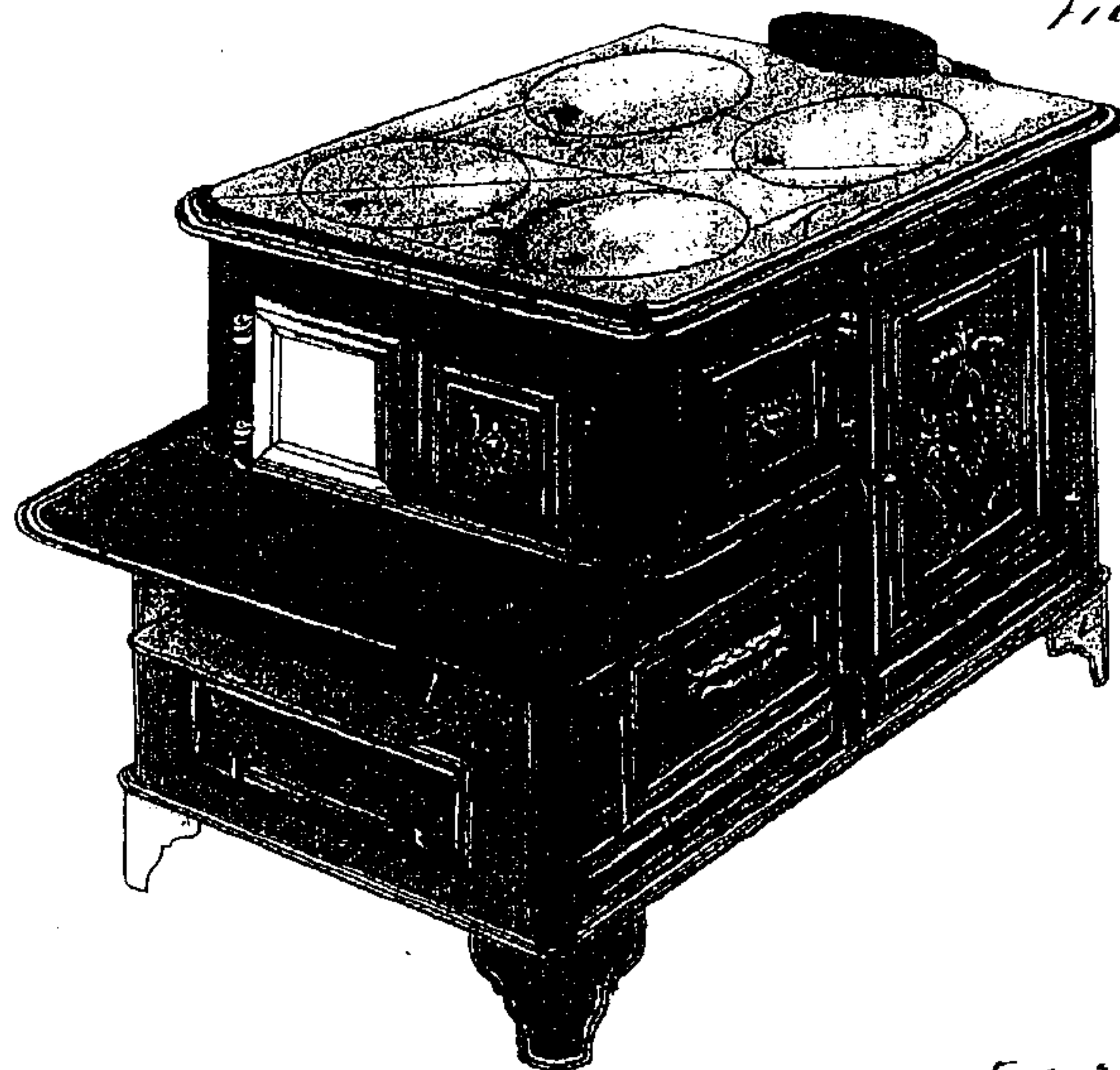

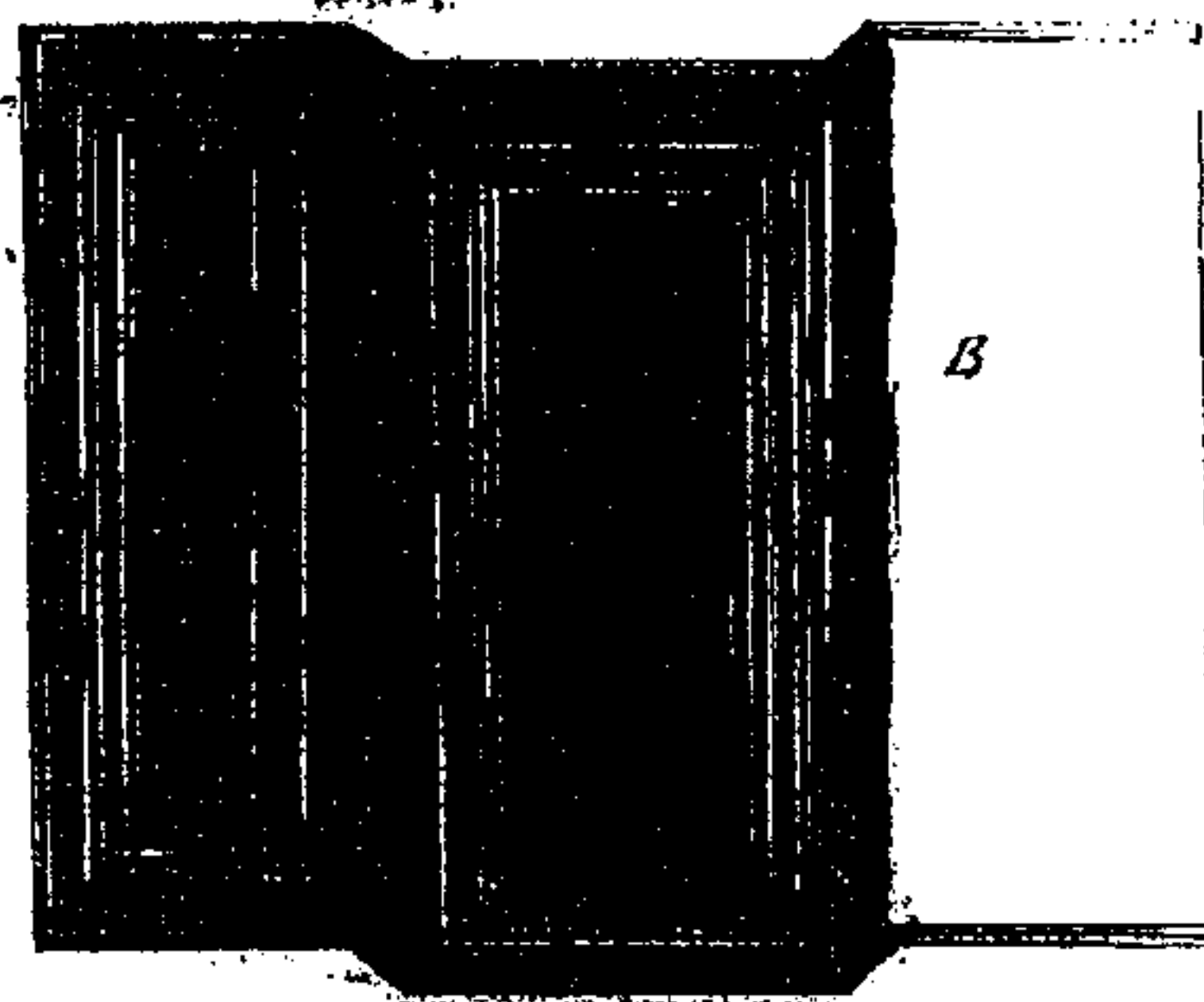

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I Saml. D. Vose, of Albany, County of Albany and State of New York, have invented or produced a new ornamental design for an Air Tight Cook Stove, and I do hereby declare that the following is a full and exact description of the same, reference being had to the annexed drawings affixed and making part of this specification.

The side not seen in the drawings is fac simile to the side shown.

My invention consists in the combination of the several mouldings and ornaments as arranged in the whole stove & is not easily described in words & reference is therefore made to the drawings.

I do not claim any detailed part of the mouldings, or configuration.

What I claim as my invention and desire to secure by Letters Patent is the combination of the several mouldings and ornaments as arranged together, the whole forming an ornamental design for an air tight cook stove, as herein set
