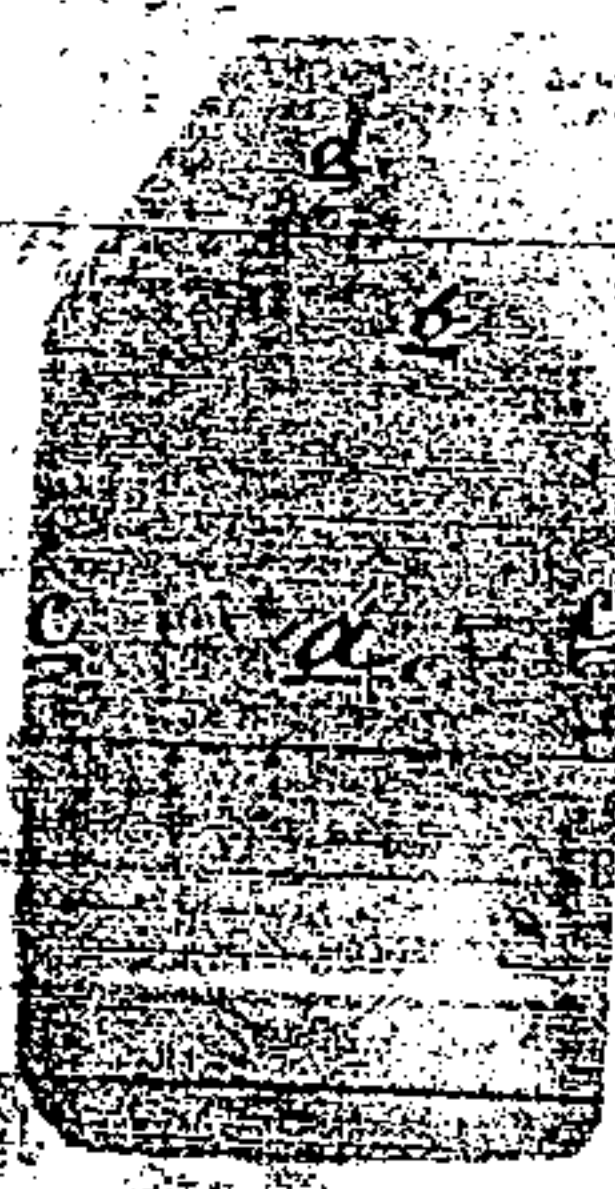

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that J. Lemuel Morgan, of South Norwalk, Conn. of Fairfield and State of Connecticut, have invented or produced a new and original Pattern or design for Fire Shovel, and I do hereby declare that the following is a full and exact description of the same: and referring to the accompanying Photograph is Views, in which the same letters indicate like parts in each of the figures.

In the accompanying Photographic Views -

Fig: 1, Shows a front elevation of my new pattern or Design for fire Shovel, &c. and

Fig: 2, Shows a back side view of the same.

a, is a flat bottom emfigurated with a curved, slanted end b, flat slanted sides c, and a beaded handle socket d, combined to constitute a plain and tasteful Pattern or design for a fire coal or ash shovel.

I claim the form and configuration of a Pattern or Design for fire, coal or ash shovel as described and represented.
