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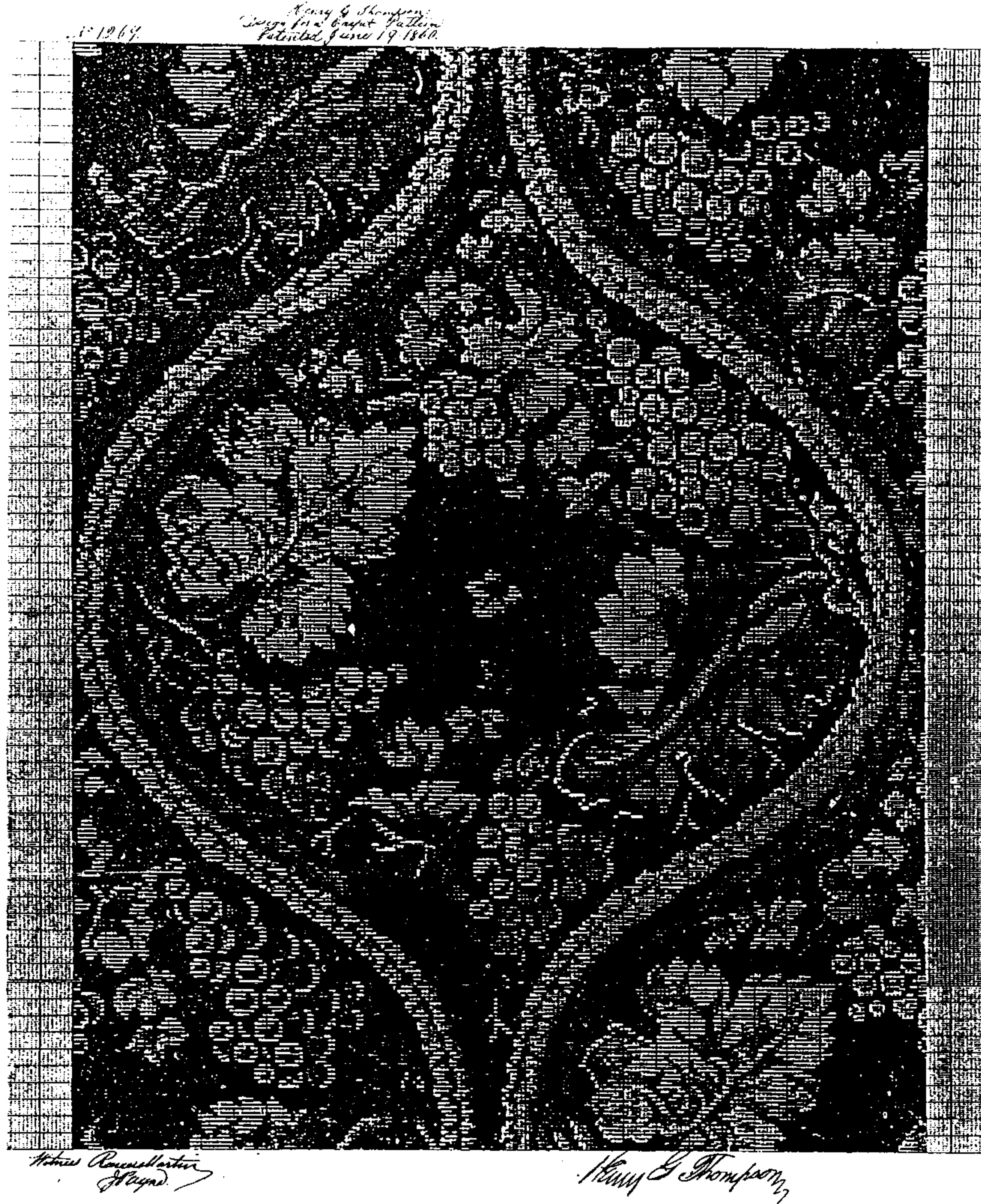

To all whom it may concern;

Be it known that I, Henry G. Thompson, of the City, County and State of New York, have invented or produced a new and original Design for a Pattern to be wrought into Three ply Ingrain and other Carpeting, in colors similar to those painted on the drawings accompanying this Specification, or in other colors substituted in the place of those painted on the drawings hereunto; and I do hereby declare that the drawings accompanying this Specification, do give and convey to anyone skilled in the art of Carpet Weaving, a more defined and thorough description of the nature of my invention than it is in the power of language otherwise to convey, and sufficient to enable any one skilled in the art of Carpet Weaving, to use my invention.

What I claim as my invention and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is the configuration of the Design hereunto annexed, when made by being wrought into Three ply Ingrain or other Carpeting, in the form similar to the drawings accompanying this Specification.
