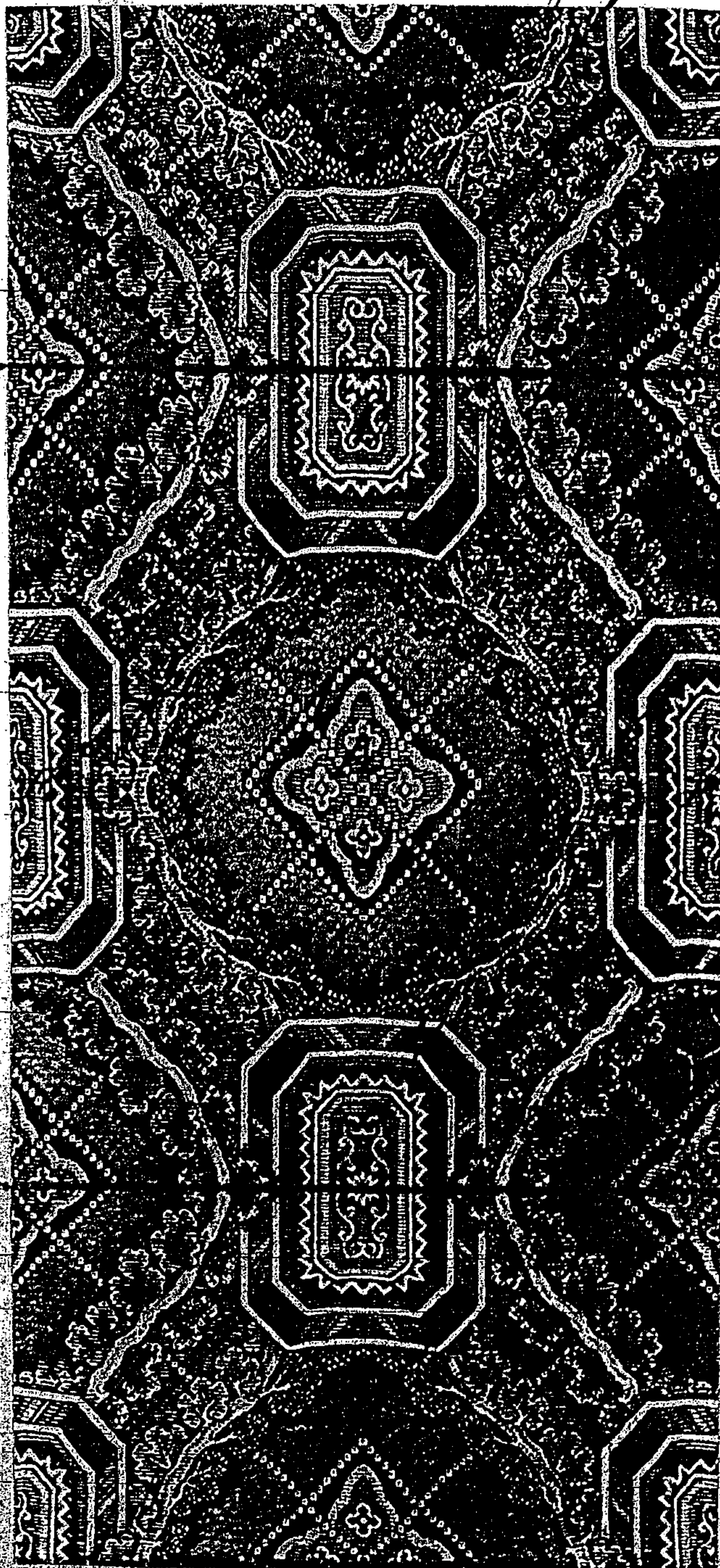

Design for a Carpet Pattern

The schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

To all whom it may concern,

Be it known that I, Elemir J. Key of Lowell, in the County of Middlesex and State of Massachusetts, have originated and designed a new Pattern for Carpets or other fabrics, of which the following is a full, clear and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, making part of this specification.

This specification refers to that part of the drawings enclosed by blue lines. A in the centre is a set figure, composed of four rosettes resting on a ground of parallel lines surrounded by a narrow band. The frame of small blocks encloses figure A and is surrounded by the dotted ground B. The curved branches 2, 3, partially enclose the ground B. In the four corners are fourths of figures similar to A, surrounded by frames and grounds similar to 1 and B. The dotted grounds are also partially enclosed by curved branches.

C and D, when matched, form an oblong set figure, surrounded by a broad frame formed by matching figs 4, 5.

Band E at the sides are halves of figures similar to C and D. 5, 5, are halves of frames similar to 4, 5. Running diagonally across the design and crossing each other in the centre are two chains of square blocks. These chains run under the curved branches before mentioned.

The colors employed for the different portions of the design, may be varied to suit the taste and wish of the manufacturer.
