Design for a Parlor Stove.

The schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

To all whom it may concern;

Be it known that we, Henry S. Hubbell and Alfred S. Hubbell of the City of Buffalo, the County of Erie, and State of New York, have invented or produced a new and original design for a parlor heating stove called the "Western Comfort" and we do hereby declare that the following is a full and exact description of the same, reference being had to the accompanying photograph and the letters of reference marked thereon.

A and B are the two upper doors.

C and D are the two lower doors.

E the lower front plate to or on which the doors C and D are hung or otherwise fastened.

What we claim as our invention and desire to secure by Letters Patent is the design and configuration of the doors and lower front as represented in the accompanying photograph.
