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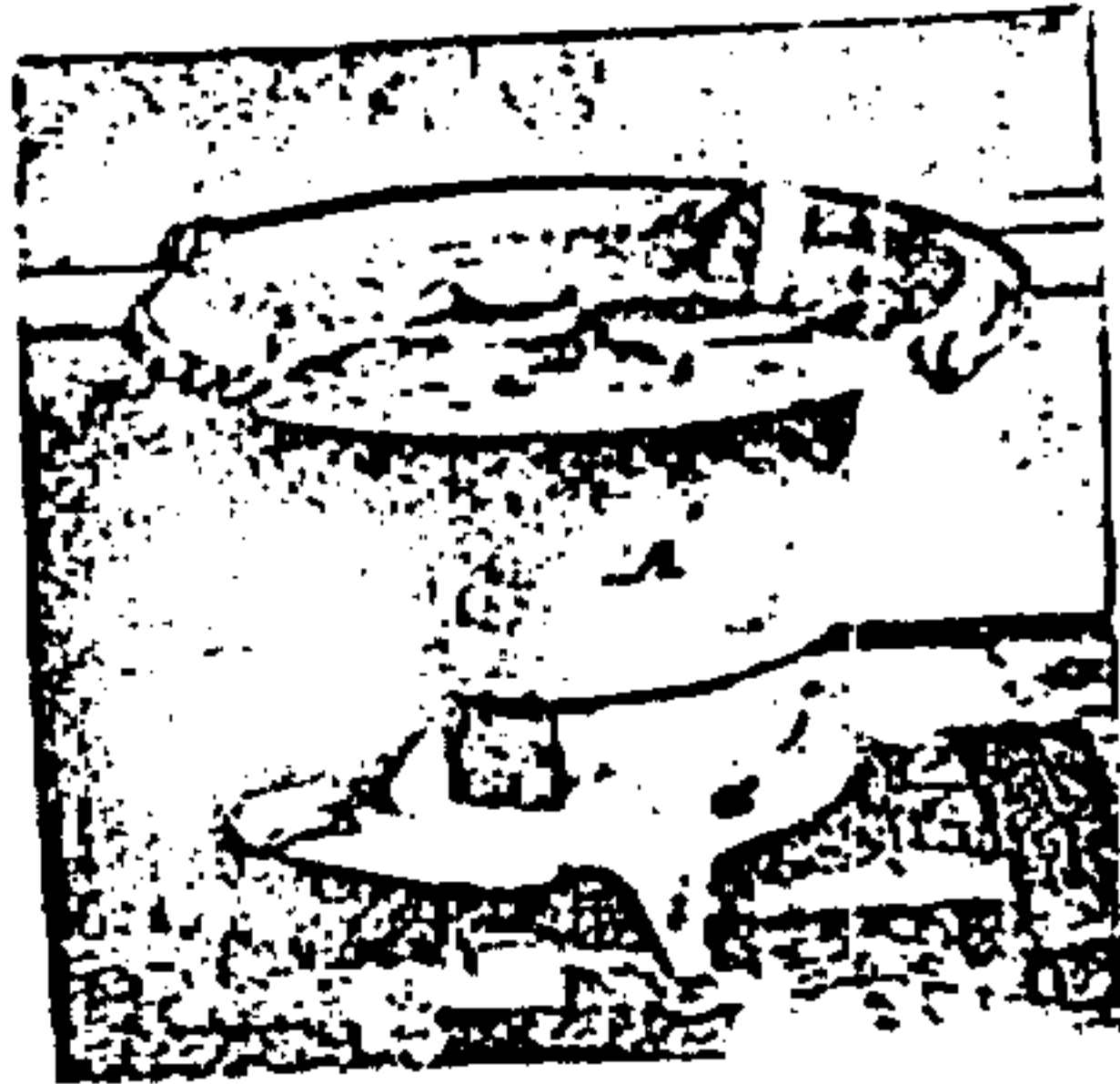

 Design for a Portable Furnace

The schedule refers to in these Letters Patent & making part of the same

To all whom it may concern;

Be it known that we J. Martin, J. Beesly and J. Currie of Philadelphia County of Philadelphia State of Pennsylvania have invented or produced a new and original design for a portable furnace, and we do hereby declare the accompanying Drawing with the following explanation of the same to form a full clear and exact description of the said Design.

The figure in the accompanying drawing represents a portable furnace in perspective.

A is the body of the furnace, at the upper edge of which is an ornamental moulding a of the character shown in the drawing.

On the edge of the base plate B, is an ornamental moulding a' similar to the moulding a, and on each foot C is an ornamental figure i.

Within the furnace is an ornamental frame D.

We claim.

The design for a portable furnace, substantially as shown in and by the accompanying drawing.
