

DESIGN FOR A TRADE-MARK.

The Schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

TO ALL PERSONS TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME:

Be it known that I, GEORGE BRETT, of North Easton, in the county of Bristol, and State of Massachusetts, have invented or produced a new ornamental Design for a Trade-Mark; and do hereby declare the same to be described as follows, and to be represented in the accompanying drawing, in which—

A denotes an embossed gaiter shoe resting on a lance-pole, B, provided with a lance-head, *a*, at each end, the whole being within a shield formed of the two ellipses C D.

I claim the design, consisting of the shoe and double-headed lance, arranged together and in a shield, as described and shown.
