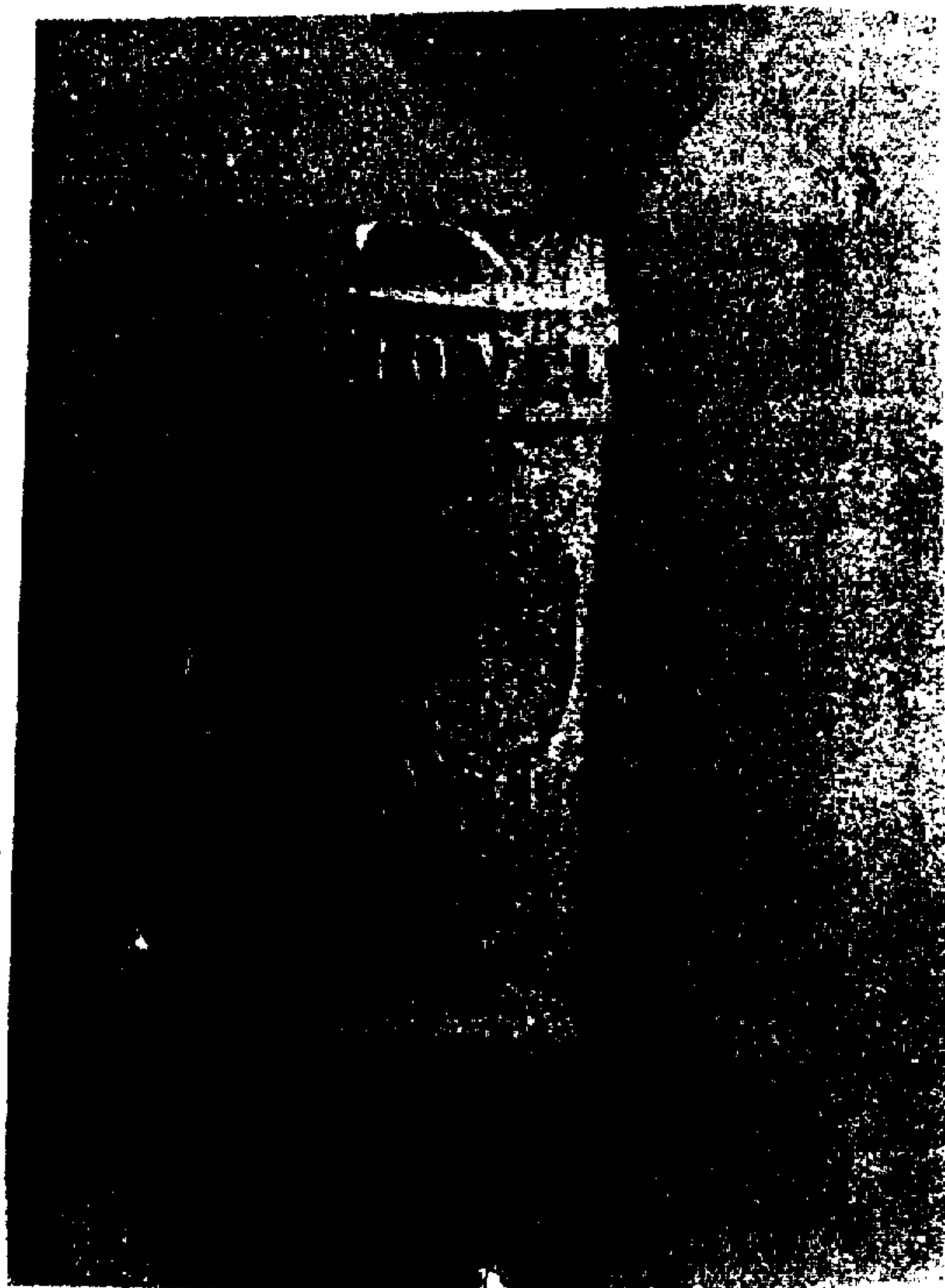

DESIGN FOR A CIGAR-HOLDER.

Specification forming part of Design No. 5,998, dated July 16, 1872.

Specification describing a new and original Design for Cigar-Holder, invented by OSCAR F. BALSTON, of Lake Mahopac, in the county of Putnam and State of New York.

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying photographic illustration, to which reference is made.

A is a tube of vulcanized rubber. B is a raised band near the outer end of the tube, with the word "novelty" thereon. C is a raised oval ground in the center of the tube.

D is a round flange at the mouth-end of the tube.

This cigar-holder is designed to be cast in a mold and formed of vulcanized India rubber.

I claim as my invention—

The design for a cigar-holder, substantially as shown.
