

## DESIGN FOR A PARLOR-STOVE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 12,174, dated February 15, 1881.

Application filed January 18, 1881. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, GARRETTSON SMITH, a citizen of the United States, residing in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented a new and original Design for a Parlor-Stove, of which the following is a specification.

My design is fully shown in the accompanying drawing, which represents a perspective

view of the stove.

The design comprises the top section, A, with urn a, magazine-section B, illuminating-section D, fire-pot section E, and base-section F.

The urn a comprises the stem b, inverted conical lower part, d, semi-spherical top e, and

15 surrounding ornament f.

The magazine-section B is divided by vertical pillars g into a number of panels, each having an ornamental border, h, and a central tablet, i, ornamented as shown.

The illuminating-section D has a series of doors, each with five mica panels, m.

The fire-pot section E consists of an open-work screen.

The base-section F has ornamented panels n, ash-pit door, with panel s, and damper t, beaded base w, and segmental fender x.

I claim—

1. The design for the urn, said design comprising the stem b, conical base d, semi-spher-

ical top e, and surrounding ornament f, as 30 shown and described.

2. The design for the magazine-section B, said design comprising panels with ornamental borders h, and the central tablets, i, as shown and described.

3. The design for the magazine-section B, said design comprising the panels with ornamental borders h and tablets i, and the vertical separating pillars g, as shown and described.

4. The design for the base-section F, said 40 design comprising the ornamented panels n, ash - pit door, with panel s, and damper t, beaded base w, and segmental fender x, as shown and described.

5. The design for the complete stove, said 45 design comprising the top section, A, with urn a, magazine-section B, with ornamented panels, illuminating-section D, with mica-paneled doors, open-work fire-pot section E, and base-section F, all ornamented, as shown and described.
