DESIGN FOR OIL-CLOTH.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 12,224, dated April 12, 1881.

Application filed February 28, 1881. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, CHARLES T. MEYER
and VICTOR E. MEYER, of Bergen, county of
Hudson, State of New Jersey, have originated
5 and designed a new Pattern for Floor Oil-
Cloths, Carpets, or other Fabrics, of which the
following is a full, clear, and exact description,
reference being had to the accompanying speci-
men or drawing, making part of this specifi-
10 cation, which fully represents said design, and
is sufficient, without further aid, to enable any
person skilled in the art to repeat it for prac-
tical use.

The colors employed for the different por-
tions of this design may be varied to suit the 15
convenience or taste of the manufacturer.

What we claim as our invention, and desire
to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design or pattern for floor oil-cloths, car-
pets, or other fabrics, as shown.
