

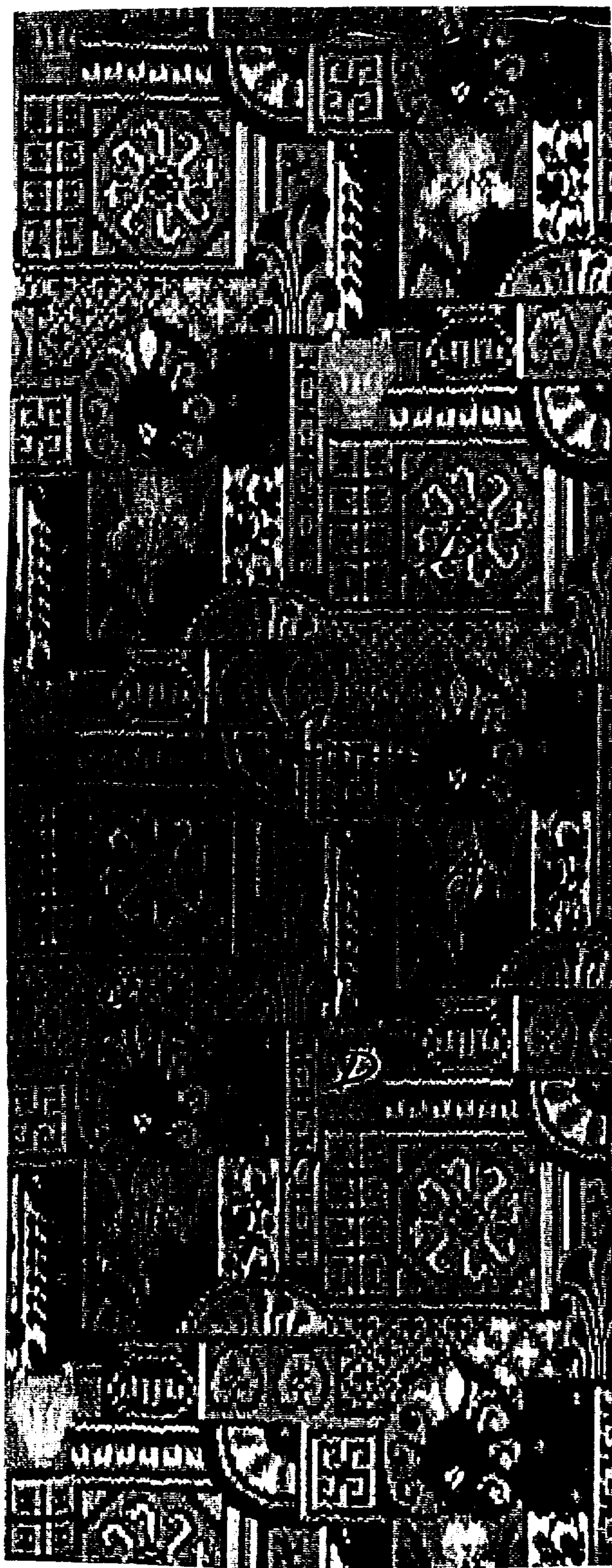

DESIGN FOR A CARPET.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 12,328, dated June 21, 1881.

Application filed May 3, 1881. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{4}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, THOMAS J. STEARNS, of Boston, in the county of Suffolk and State of Massachusetts, have invented a certain new
5 and original Design for Carpets, of which the following is a specification.

My present design is fully shown in the accompanying photographic illustration, forming part of this specification.

10 The design is composed of the following elements, viz: The figures A, (representing a blooming plant in a vase,) arranged alternately in parallel rows, the ornamented geometrical figures B, the irregular figures C, the figures

D, (representing urns or vases,) the lotus-flower 15 ornamentation E, the detached borders G and H, and the figures J, all disposed as shown.

I claim—

The design for a carpet, substantially as shown and described. 20
