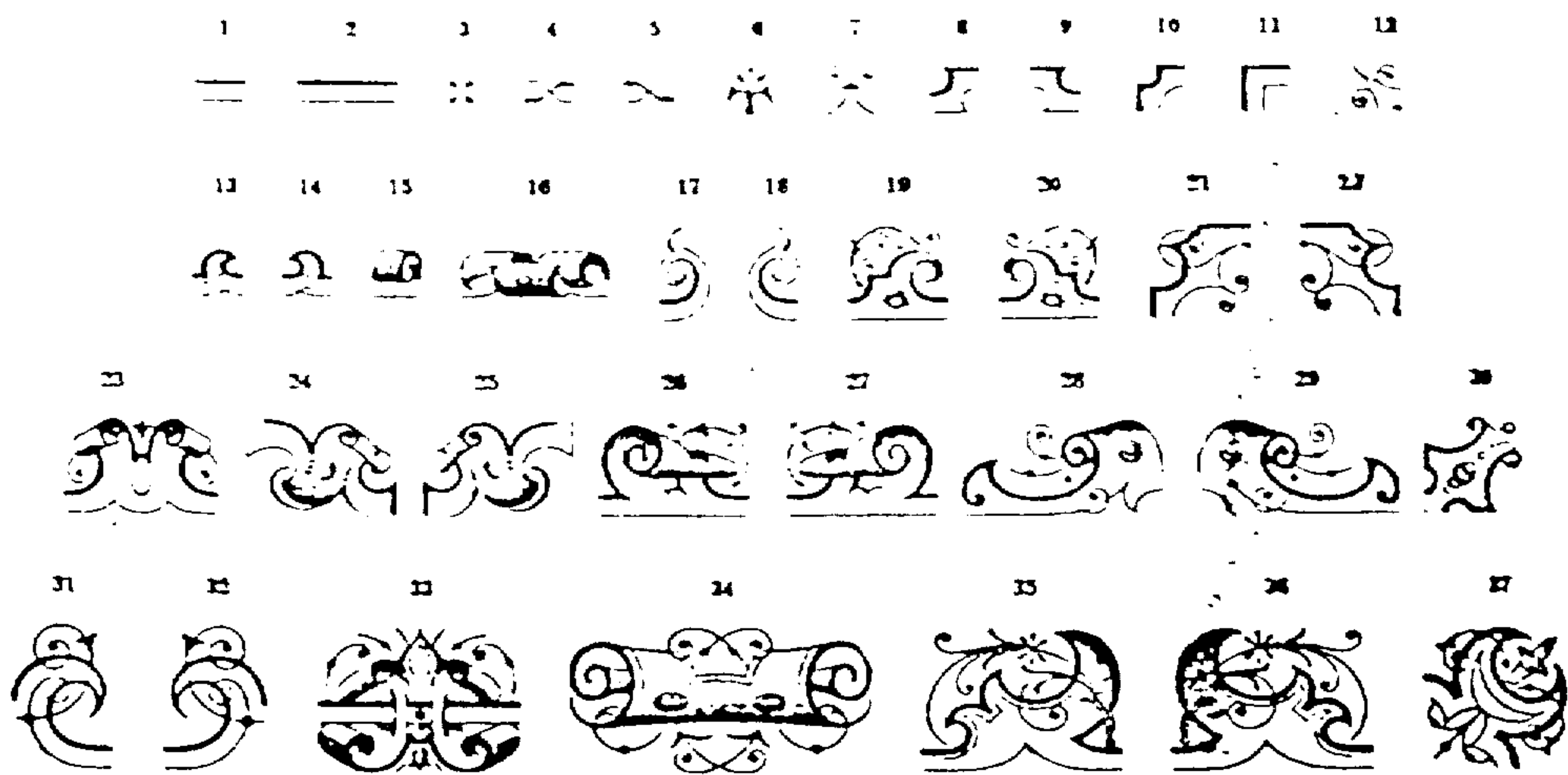

## DESIGN FOR A FONT OF PRINTING-TYPE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 12,329, dated June 21, 1881.

Application filed April 6, 1881. Term of patent 14 years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, AUGUST WILL, assignor  
to DAVID WOLFE BRUCE, of Jersey City, Hud-  
son county, New Jersey, have invented and  
5 produced a new and original Design for a Font  
of Printing-Type, of which the following is a  
specification.

The types composing this font are repre-  
sented in the accompanying sheet of drawings,  
10 which is made up of impressions from the types  
themselves, and shows the exact configuration

of their faces in a series of figures numbered  
from 1 to 37, inclusive.
