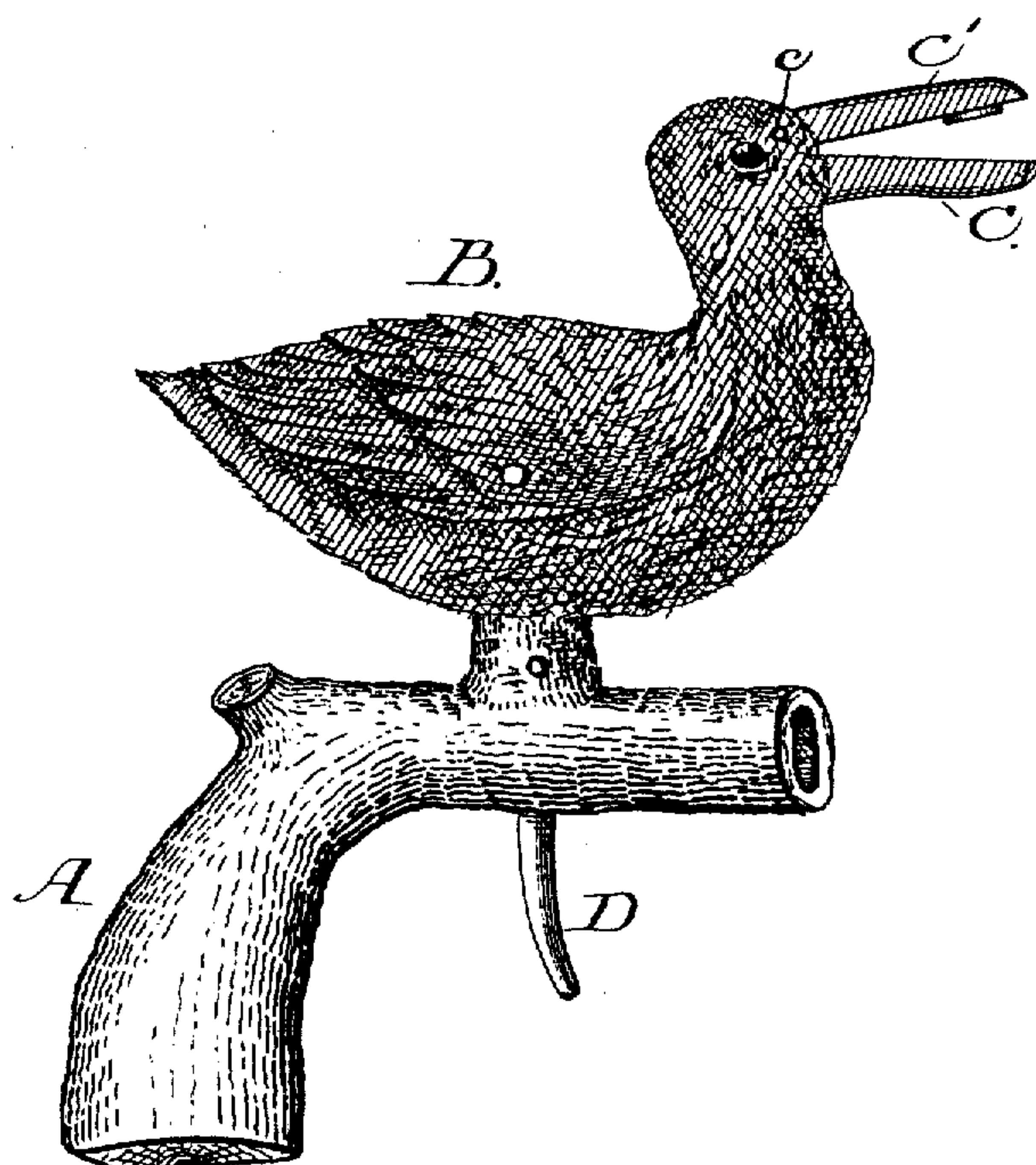

DESIGN FOR A TOY PISTOL.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 13,974, dated June 12, 1883.

Application filed March 30, 1883. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, GEO. S. CROSBY, a citizen of the United States, residing at Bridgeport, in the county of Fairfield and State of Connecticut, have invented and produced a new and original Design for Toy Pistols; and I do hereby declare the following to be a full, clear, and exact description of the invention, such as will enable others skilled in the art to which it appertains to make and use the same.

The accompanying drawing, forming part of this specification, shows an elevation of my new and original design.

It will of course be understood that my design embraces such changes as do not depart in substantial appearance from the accompanying illustration.

The leading features of my design are the configuration of the body of the pistol itself, which is made in imitation of a piece of a bent branch or limb of a tree and the figure of a duck standing thereon.

A is the body of the pistol, made to represent a portion of a branch of a tree. The front end represents the barrel, which has an opening in the end. B is the figure of a duck standing on the branch.

Having thus described my invention, I claim as new and desire to secure by Letters Patent—

1. The design for toy pistols herein shown and described.

2. The design for toy pistols herein shown and described, the same consisting of a bent limb or branch of a tree having the figure of a duck mounted thereon.
