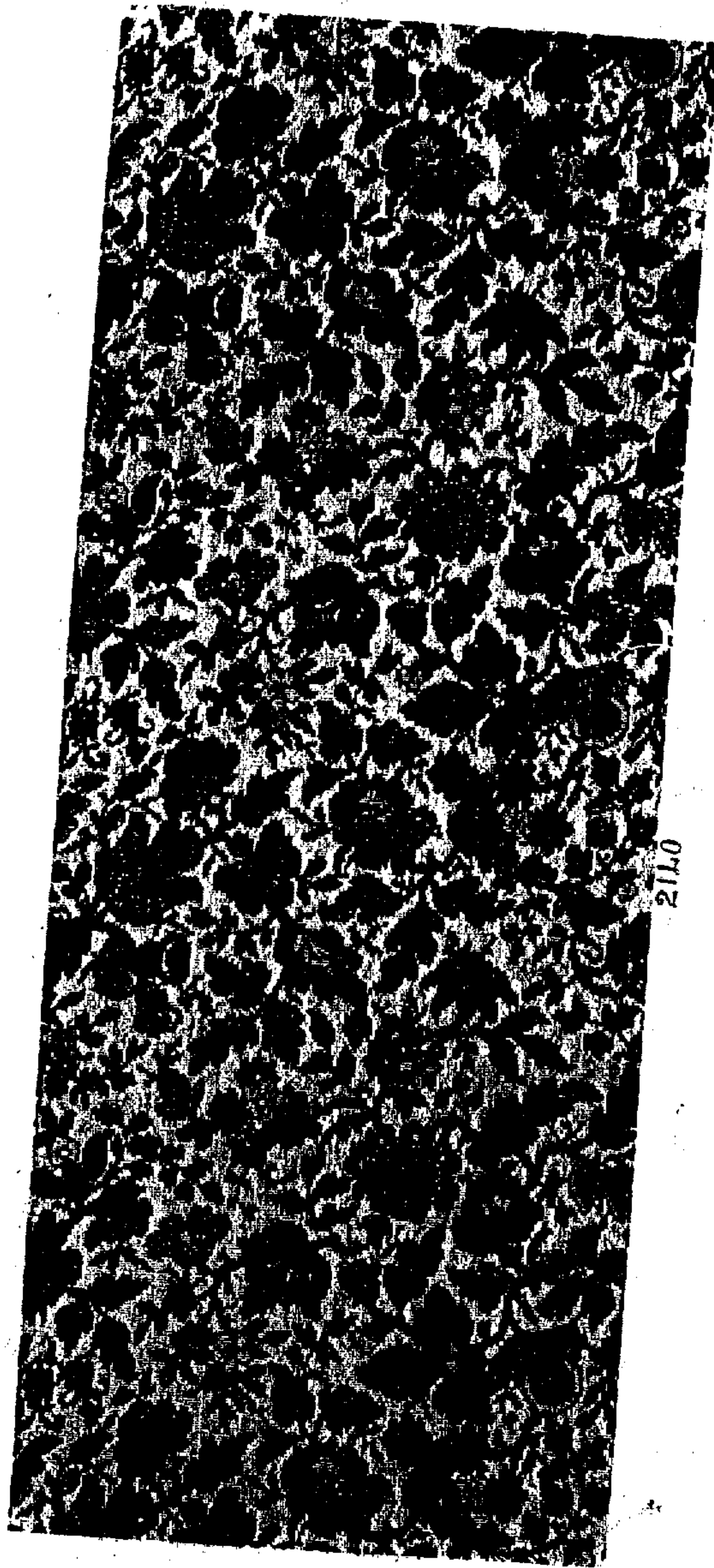

DESIGN FOR A CARPET.

Application filed August 13, 1883. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{4}$ years.
