

## DESIGN FOR A CARPET.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 14,306, dated September 18, 1883.

Application filed August 13, 1883. Term of patent 34 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, DAVID G. MELVILLE, of Medford, in the county of Middlesex and State of Massachusetts, have invented a new and original Design for a Carpet, of which the following is a specification.

The nature of my design is fully shown in the accompanying photographic illustration.

The design is composed of the floral and foliage ornamentation forming a tracery on a contrasting ground, as shown.
