SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 14,409, dated November 13, 1883.

Application filed October 5, 1883. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM W. JACKSON, (assignor to FARMER, LITTLE & Co.,) of the city and county of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, the lower have invented and produced a new and original Design for a Font of Printing-Type, of which the following is a specification.

The design for a Font of Printing-Type, of the city the lower having as new—which the following is a specification.

The nature of my design is clearly shown in the accompanying typographic impression, to which reference is made; and it consists of an unshaded script letter, as shown. In the U, V, W, and Y the right-hand up-and-down por-

tion of the letter is shorter than the left-hand portion.

The character of the design is preserved in 15 the lower-case and figures.
