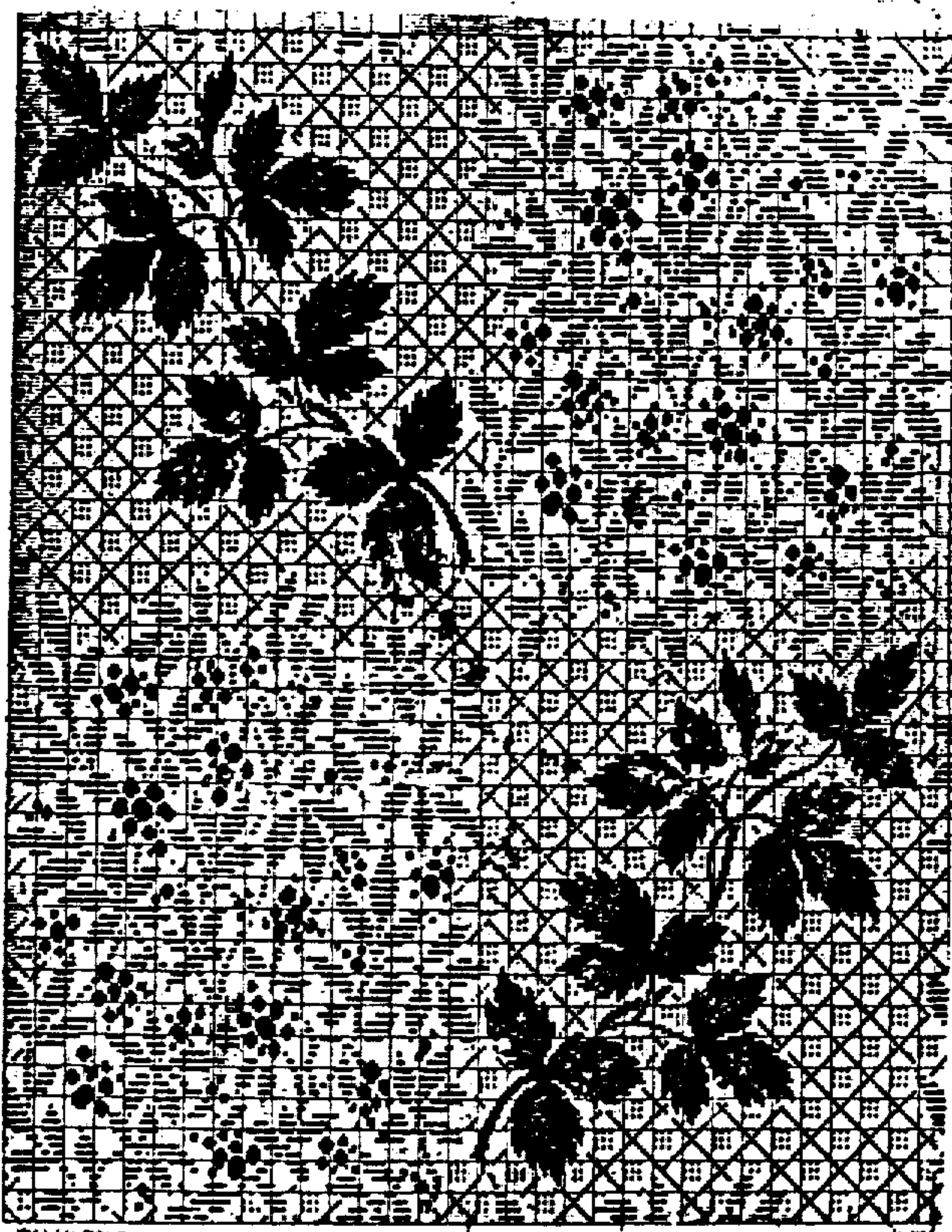

DESIGN FOR A CARPET.
