DESIGN FOR A CARPET.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 14,898, dated March 25, 1884.

Application filed February 19, 1884. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, EDWIN FISHER, of the
city of Boston, and county of Suffolk, and
State of Massachusetts, have invented and
5 produced a new and original Design for a Pat-
tern to be Inwrought in Two or Three Ply In-
grain and other Carpeting, in such colors as
may be desired; and I do hereby declare that
the photographic print accompanying this
10 specification conveys to any one skilled in the
art of carpet-weaving a clear understanding of
the same, and is sufficient to enable such per-
son to use my invention.

What I claim as my invention, and desire to
secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for ingrain or other carpeting,
consisting in the ornamentation shown in the
photographic print accompanying this speci-
fication.
