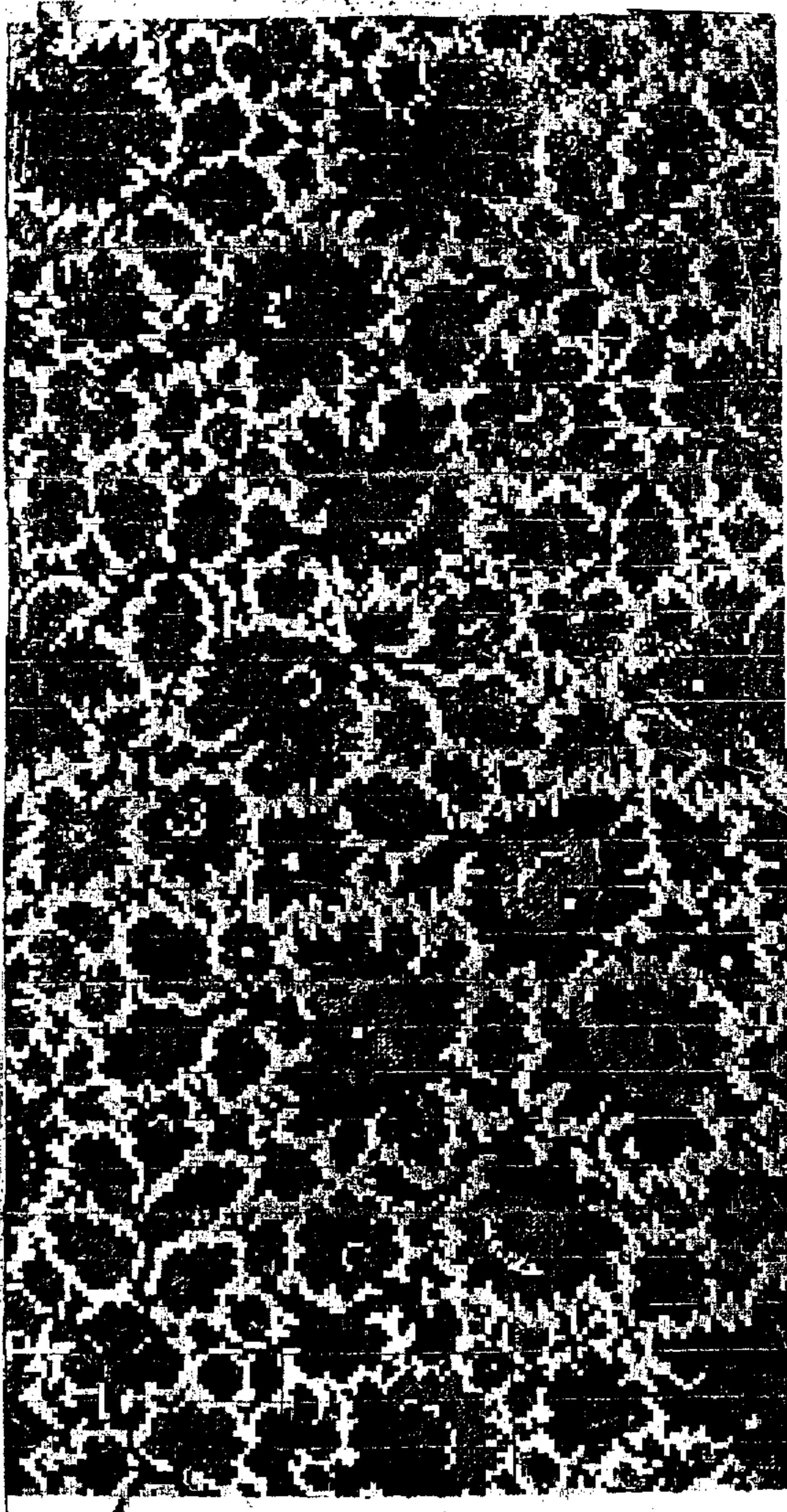

## DESIGN FOR A CARPET.

**SPECIFICATION** forming part of Design No. 15,442, dated October 7, 1884.

Application filed August 6, 1884. Term of patent 3½ years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, W. L. JACOBS, of East Orange, New Jersey, have invented a new and original Design for Carpets, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying photograph, which forms a part of the same.

The invention relates to a design to be worked into or upon surfaces, such as carpets or similar fabrics; and it consists in the novel configuration and grouping of figures herein specifically shown and claimed.

The accompanying photograph is a face view of a carpet, showing my new design.

On an inconspicuous net-work of stems are displayed various large conventionalized flower figures and smaller leaf figures, the whole closely and evenly filling in the face of the design.

I claim—

The design for a carpet, substantially as shown and described.
