

DESIGN FOR A CARPET.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 15,443, dated October 7, 1884.

Application filed August 6, 1884. Term of patent 35 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, W. L. JACOBS, of East Orange, New Jersey, have invented a new and original Design for Carpets, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying photograph, which forms a part of the same.

The invention relates to a design to be worked into or upon surfaces, such as carpets or similar fabrics; and it consists in the novel configuration and grouping of figures herein specifically shown and claimed.

The accompanying photograph is a face view of a carpet, showing my new design.

15 The design consists of variously-grouped

gem figures displayed on inconspicuous angular stems with conventionalized leaf forms, and of various irregular blocks of small geometric work closely crowded into the spaces between the larger gem figures.

The design is clearly shown in the photograph.

Telaim-

The design for a carpet, consisting of the design substantially as shown and described.
