## DESIGN FOR PRINTING-TYPE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 15,557, dated November 18, 1884.

Application filed September 19, 1884. Term of patent 14 years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, HERMAN IHLENBURG, (assignor to MACKELLAR, SMITHS & JORDAN,) of the city and county of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented and produced a new Design for a Font of Printing-Type, of which the following is a specification.

The nature of my design is clearly shown in the accompanying typographic impression, to which reference is made; and it consists of a series of initial letters ornamented upon the right hand by the figure composed of the upper and lower parallel lines, with open space between them, and connected upon the left by the vertical line, as shown, so that the letters present the appearance of having been mortised. The upper cross-line is further ornamented above by the short curved line terminating in a heavy dot. The lower cross-line is similarly ornamented, save that the curved

line is placed below it; and the points of intersection are ornamented where the cross-lines meet the vertical line upon the left by a short heavy inclined line placed between the curved terminations of the cross-lines and the curved terminations of the vertical line.

In connection with the font, to be used for further ornamentation of any of the letters, are shown a series of figures numbered from 1 to 10, inclusive, and reference is made to the typographic impression showing their exact configuration.

Having now described my invention, I claim—

The design for a font of printing-type, substantially as shown and described.
